Action

I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman for the 2005-2006 session

Election of Chairman

Mr James TO, the Chairman, called for nominations for the chairmanship of the Panel. Mr James TO was nominated by Mr LAU Kong-wah and the nomination was seconded by Mr Howard YOUNG and Mr WONG Yung-kan. Mr James TO accepted the nomination.

2. <u>Mr Daniel LAM</u>, the Deputy Chairman, took over from Mr James TO to preside over the election. As there was no other nomination, <u>Mr Daniel LAM</u> declared Mr James TO elected as Chairman of the Panel for the 2005-2006 session. Mr James TO then took the chair.

Election of Deputy Chairman

- 3. <u>The Chairman</u> called for nominations for the deputy chairmanship of the Panel. Mr Daniel LAM was nominated by Mr WONG Yung-kan and the nomination was seconded by Mr CHEUNG Man-kwong. <u>Mr Daniel LAM</u> accepted the nomination.
- 4. As there was no other nomination, the Chairman declared Mr Daniel LAM elected as Deputy Chairman of the Panel for the 2005-2006 session.

Appeal on the case between LEUNG Kwok-hung, FUNG Ka-keung, Christopher, LO Wai-ming and the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region on 8 July 2005; and

- (c) long-term prison development.
- 7. <u>Members</u> agreed that the discussion on the item referred to in paragraph 6(a) above would be held in camera.
- 8. <u>Members</u> noted that briefings by the Secretary for Security and Commissioner, Independent Commission Against Corruption on the Chief Executive's 2005-2006 Policy Address had been scheduled for 19 October 2005 from 9:30 am to 11:00 am.
- 9. Regarding the item "Proposed legislative amendments providing for maintenance of records of births, deaths and marriages in digital image" proposed by the Administration, <u>members</u> agreed that the Administration should be requested to provide an information paper before a decision was made on whether the item should be discussed by the Panel.

IV. Any other business

<u>Subcommittee on Review of Existing Statutory Provisions on Search and Seizure</u> of Journalistic Material

- 10. <u>Members</u> agreed that the Subcommittee on Review of Existing Statutory Provisions on Search and Seizure of Journalistic Material would continue its work in the 2005-2006 session and its membership would be re-opened to Panel members. <u>Members</u> also agreed that the Subcommittee would decide whether it was necessary to re-elect its Chairman.
