Report on Follow-up Action by Police LegCo Panel in Security Meeting on 24 January 2006

- (1) Statistics on persons prosecuted for offences committed after cautioned under the Superintendent's Discretion Scheme and the nature of the offence involved.
 - A person is regarded as a recidivist if he/she is re-arrested for crime within two years from the date of caution, or before he/she reaches 18 years of age, whichever occurs first. As such, the most up-to-date information the Police would be able to provide is the recidivism rate concerning persons arrested and cautioned in 2003.
 - 3,012 persons were arrested and cautioned under the PSDS in 2003, out of which 589 were arrested within two years, giving a recidivist rate of 19.6%.
 - Number of persons cautioned under the PSDS in 2003 and re-arrested/re-cautioned within 2 years are as follows:

• In respect of the handling method, out of the 589 recidivists, 96 were re-cautioned (16.3%). However, there is no separate statistics maintained as to the number of recidivists charged to court or alternatively released.

(2) Information on the percentage decrease in juvenile and youth population in 2005;

- In 2005, the number of juvenile arrested was 4 531. This represents a decrease of 366 (-7.5%) when compared with the number of 4 897 in 2004.
