Retraining Services for People with Disabilities

Retraining programmes/courses are funded by the Employees Retraining Board (ERB) and delivered by its approved list of training bodies. Among the 50 and more training bodies approved for conducting retraining programmes under the ERS, 15 of them offer courses specifically for people with disabilities. A list of these 15 training bodies is at <u>Appendix 1</u>.

A wide range of full-time and part-time retraining programmes are tailor-made for people with disabilities, which can be grouped under two major categories. The first category is *job specific skills training* courses which include 'catering services training', 'tele-marketing training', 'telephone interviewer training', 'desktop publishing training', 'homepage design training', 'reception and clerical work training', 'cleaning service training', 'standard security & property management training' and 'shop assistant training', etc. The second category is **basic generic skills training** such as 'pre-employment induction training', 'computer application training' and 'vocational Putonghua training'.

Placement-tied retraining programmes also cover adjustment training and follow-up placement services in order to help the disabled retrainees to find suitable jobs and hold down their jobs. From April 2005 to March 2006, a total of 734 retrainees had completed training programmes tailor-made for the disabled.
