1. Degree and Other Awards

Statute 26 of the Statutes of The Chinese University of Hong Kong in Schedule 1 to The Chinese University of Hong Kong Ordinance (Cap. 1109) is amended—

- (a) in paragraph 1(1), by repealing “the degrees of Bachelor, Master and Doctor” and substituting “any of the degrees”;
- (b) in paragraph 2(1)(a)—
 - (i) by repealing “Bachelor’s Degrees”;
 - (ii) by adding “Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.)”;
- (c) in paragraph 2(1)(b)—
 - (i) by repealing “Master’s Degrees”;
 - (ii) by adding “Master of Laws (LL.M.)”;
- (d) by renumbering paragraph 2(1)(c) as paragraph 2(1)(d);
- (e) in paragraph 2(1)(d)—
 - (i) by repealing “Doctoral Degrees”;
 - (ii) by adding “Doctor of Psychology (Psy.D.)”;
- (f) in paragraph 2(1), by adding—
 - “(c) Juris Doctor (J.D.)”.

Explanatory Note

This Statute amends the Statutes of The Chinese University of Hong Kong in Schedule 1 to The Chinese University of Hong Kong Ordinance (Cap. 1109) to provide for the conferring of the following new degrees: Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.), Master of Laws (LL.M.), Juris Doctor (J.D.) and Doctor of Psychology (Psy.D.), by the University.
