

L.N. 92 of 2006**CHIROPRACTORS REGISTRATION (FEE REVISION)
REGULATION 2006**

(Made by the Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury under section 29A of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) by virtue of section 27 of the Chiropractors Registration Ordinance (Cap. 428))

1. Commencement

This Regulation shall come into operation on 1 July 2006.

2. Fees

The Schedule to the Chiropractors Registration (Fees) Regulation (Cap. 428 sub. leg. A) is amended—

- (a) in item 1, by repealing “3,055” and substituting “3,360”;
- (b) in item 2, by repealing “1,240” and substituting “1,360”;
- (c) in item 3, by repealing “1,240” and substituting “1,360”;
- (d) in item 4, by repealing “2,370” and substituting “2,610”;
- (e) in item 5, by repealing “655” and substituting “720”;
- (f) in item 6, by repealing “700” and substituting “770”;
- (g) in item 7, by repealing “700” and substituting “770”;
- (h) in item 8, by repealing “73” and substituting “43”.

Explanatory Note

This Regulation amends the Schedule to the Chiropractors Registration (Fees) Regulation (Cap. 428 sub. leg. A)—

- (a) to reduce the fee payable for each folio of 72 words or part thereof of a verbatim record of proceedings of an inquiry held by the Inquiry Committee established by the Chiropractors Council; and

- (b) to increase the fees payable for the application for registration and certification of registration as a registered chiropractor, application for issue and renewal of practising certificates, certification of the Secretary to the Chiropractors Council on certain matters and restoration of an applicant's name to the register of registered chiropractors under the Chiropractors Registration Ordinance (Cap. 428).
