**1. Maximum concentration of certain substances
present in specified foods**

The First Schedule to the Harmful Substances in Food Regulations
(Cap. 132 sub. leg. AF) is amended by adding—

“26A. Malachite green	Sum of malachite green and leucomalachite green	Any food (including live fish, live reptiles and live poultry)	0 microgram per kilogram of the food.”.

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Explanatory Note

This Regulation amends the First Schedule to the Harmful Substances in Food Regulations (Cap. 132 sub. leg. AF). The effect is to regulate the presence of malachite green in food (including live fish, live reptiles and live poultry).
