- (1) To respond to the views of deputations, in particular the comments of Professor Ron HUI regarding the environmental impacts associated with the disposal of compact fluorescent lamps which contain high dosage of toxic mercury.
- (2) To provide an information paper setting out the enforcement actions which the Administration will take to ensure compliance with the Bill by manufacturers, importers and retailers and the penalties in the event of non-compliance.
- (3) To discuss with the trades on the feasibility of standardizing the energy-efficiency testing requirements for the three scheduled products and revert the outcome of discussion to the Bills Committee.
- (4) To discuss with the trades regarding the eligibility of laboratories for the issuance of test reports and revert the outcome of discussion to the Bills Committee.
