## Bills Committee on Energy Efficiency (Labelling of Products) Bill

## List of follow-up actions arising from the discussion at the meeting on 10 July 2007

- (1) To advise the details of the 607 applications, including the range of the one-off grants and vehicle classes, received under the one-off grant to encourage early replacement of pre-Euro and Euro I diesel commercial vehicles.
- (2) To step up publicity on the energy efficiency performance and longer lifespan of compact fluorescent lamps (CFLs) with a view to promoting the use of CFLs. To also advise the Administration's plan to address the environmental impacts associated with the disposal of used CFLs. Consideration should be given to setting up collection points in the 18 districts for the collection of used CFLs from domestic premises for treatment in the Chemical Waste Treatment Centre pending the passage of the Product Eco-responsibility Bill. To also advise the organizations which have put in place a voluntary collection system for used CFLs.
- (3) To consider turning the Building Energy Codes into mandatory requirements. To also relay to the Secretary for the Environment that the subject of building energy efficiency will be brought up at the forthcoming meeting of the Panel on Environmental Affairs on 20 July 2007 at which he will brief members on the policy initiatives under the environment and nature conservation portfolios.
- (4) To advise whether ordinances with similar provision for codes of practices have specific requirement for consultation with stakeholders in the preparation of the codes.
