I. Meeting with deputations and the Administration

[LC Paper Nos. CB(2)1715/06-07(01) and CB(2)1775/06-07(01)]

The Bills Committee deliberated (Index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

Views of members

- 2. <u>Members</u> noted with concern about the low attendance of postgraduates at Annual General Meetings (AGMs) and Adjourned AGMs of the City University of Hong Kong Postgraduate Association (CUPA) over the past many years. They questioned the representation and the organization power of CUPA. While agreeing that postgraduates, like undergraduates, should have the chance to participate in the business of the Council of the City University of Hong Kong (the CityU Council), members expressed reservations about the appointment of the President of CUPA as an ex-officio member of the CityU Council. <u>Members</u> noted that under the existing arrangement, the CityU Council was responsible for holding election of staff representatives for appointment to the Council. After discussion, members agreed with the CityU Council that -
 - (a) there should be a representative elected from among the postgraduates of CityU in the CityU Council;
 - (b) the CityU Council would be responsible for holding the election;
 - (c) the responsibility for holding the election would be passed over to CUPA when the CityU Council considered it appropriate; and
 - (d) the relevant drafting in the Bill should be along the line of section 10(1)(h) concerning election of staff members for appointment to the CityU Council.
- 3. <u>Members</u> requested the CityU Council to confirm in writing the agreed arrangements and provide the details of the election procedures, including the definition of postgraduates for the election purpose and the frequency for holding the election. The CityU Council was also requested to provide the updated Committee Stage amendments to the Bill. The CityU Council agreed.
