a) <u>Criteria for making nominations and appointments to the CityU</u> <u>Council</u>

Under section 10(1)(f) of the City University of Hong Kong Ordinance (Cap. 1132), the Chief Executive may appoint not more than 18 members to the CityU Council of whom not less than 10 shall have experience in commerce or industry in Hong Kong; and not more than 9 shall be appointed based on the recommendation of the Council.

In considering appointments to councils of tertiary institutions, the Chief Executive will take into account individual nominees' capabilities and merits, such as professional expertise, experience in business or industry, and past record of public service, etc.

Appointments made by the Chief Executive to the CityU Council have been made in accordance with the above legislation and criteria.
