  - (d) details of the "recent assessment" conducted by the Hospital Authority on the demand for interpretation service required by the ethnic minorities as referred to in paragraph 12 of the Administration's paper [LC Paper No. CB(2)1600/07-08(01)].
- 3. <u>The Chairman</u> reiterated her request that the Administration should review the drafting of Clause 26(2)(b) to improve the clarity of its scope.
