### I. Meeting with the Administration

The Bills Committee deliberated the following papers -

(a) Administration's paper entitled "The Administration's proposals for Committee Stage amendments (CSAs)" [LC Paper No. CB(2)2251/07-08(01)];

- (b) Discussion drafts of CSAs prepared by the legal adviser to the Bills Committee [LC Paper No. LS96/07-08];
- (c) Draft CSAs proposed by Dr YEUNG Sum [LC Paper No. CB(2)2251/07-08(02) and CB(2)2296/07-08(01)];
- (d) Administration's response to the outstanding general issues raised by members of the Bills Committee [LC Paper No. CB(2)2297/07-08(01)];
- (e) Administration's paper entitled "Administration's response to views received from deputations on vocational training and on interpretation services at hospitals" [LC Paper No. CB(2)2297/07-08(02)]; and
- (f) Administration's paper entitled "Administration's response to the outstanding general issues on education raised by members of the Bills Committee" [LC Paper No. CB(2)2308/07-08(01)].

## Draft CSAs to be proposed by the Administration

#### Admin

- 2. <u>The Administration</u> was requested to -
  - (a) consider the suggestion of the legal adviser to the Bills Committee that, with regard to the definition of "near relative" in Clause 2, "such" should be added before "a child" at the end of paragraph (c) and before "a grandchild," in the first line of paragraph (f);
  - (b) review in collaboration with the legal adviser to the Bills Committee the drafting of the proposed CSAs on the new definition of "sub-contractor" to enhance clarity;
  - (c) consider whether the drafting of Clause 46 as amended by the CSA to be proposed by the Administration could reflect the policy intent regarding the offence of serious vilification; and
  - (d) consult the Equal Opportunities Commission on the proposed CSA to Clause 81(3).
- 3. <u>Members</u> noted that in view of members' concerns about insufficient information including background, objectives and operation of the charities funds for the Bills Committee to assess the implications of the proposed amendments under Clauses 89 and 94 as well as the appropriateness to effect the proposed amendments in the form of related amendments as currently

proposed, the Administration decided to delete these two clauses from the Bill. The Chairman stressed that the Bills Committee did not object to the proposal of expanding the provision of relevant services to people of non-Chinese race, but considered that any legislative proposal must reflect the relevant policy and this proposal had not been properly considered at the policy level. At the Bills Committee's request, the Administration agreed that the matter would be referred to the Home Affairs Bureau for consideration.

4. The Administration was also requested to consider that, during the resumption of the Second Reading debate on the Bill, the relevant policy secretaries should speak on the Administration's commitment to provide new resources and services for new arrivals from the Mainland, to enhance the interpretation services at public hospitals, to strengthen the vocational training services for ethnic minorities, and to enhance support to meet the educational needs of non-Chinese speaking students respectively.

## Draft CSAs to be proposed by the Chairman on behalf of the Bills Committee

- 5. <u>The Bills Committee</u> agreed that the Chairman would move the following CSAs on its behalf -
  - (a) adding a new section 9A under a new Part 2A stating that "It is unlawful for the Government to discriminate against a person on the ground of race of that person in the performance of its functions or the exercise of its powers.";
  - (b) adding a new section 9B under new Part 2A imposing a general statutory duty of the Government to draw up a Race Equality Scheme:
  - (c) amending Clause 4(1) to include the application of "a provision, criteria or practice";
  - (d) deleting the reference to different treatment on the ground of permanent residency, right of abode and length of residence from Clause 8(3) and deleting the word "nationality" from Clause 8(3)(d);
  - (e) reducing the duration of the transitional period provided for small employers with not more than five employees under Clause 10 to one year and excluding Clause 10(1) relating to employment from the application of the proposed transitional period;
  - (f) deleting the proposed exemption for partnership with less than six partners; and

- (g) excluding the provision of vocational training courses and provision of medical treatment within the meaning of section 2 of Medical Clinics Ordinance (Cap. 343) from the exemption provided for under Clause 58.
- 6. <u>Members</u> noted that, as the Bills Committee had agreed to the CSAs to be proposed by the Chairman, Dr YEUNG Sum would not move any CSAs on behalf of the Democratic Party.

## ALA6 7. The legal adviser to the Bills Committee was requested to -

- (a) amend Clause 10(3) by substituting "subsections (1) and (2)" with "subsection (2)" and to delete Clause 10(10)(b); and
- (b) delete the proposed new Clauses 58(1D) and 58(1E).
- 8. Mr Howard YOUNG and Miss CHOY So-yuk indicated that the Liberal Party and the Democratic Alliance for the Betterment and Progress of Hong Kong did not support the proposed draft CSAs to be moved by the Bills Committee respectively. The Deputy Chairman also indicated that he did not support these CSAs.

## Outstanding general issues raised by members of the Bills Committee

- 9. <u>The Administration</u> was requested to provide information on the following outstanding issues -
  - (a) whether the proposed administrative guidelines would be applicable to the Social Welfare Department and whether "community services" mentioned in the relevant paper [LC Paper No. CB(2)2219/07-08(01)] covered social security services;
  - (b) details of the Hospital Authority's plan to enhance its provision of interpretation service at public hospitals, e.g. its recruitment plan of interpreters and allocation of resources for enhancing the interpretation service;
  - (c) whether sufficient copies of service guidance could be made available at immigration control points for distribution to new arrivals from the Mainland; and
  - (d) detailed information including a breakdown, by service items and costs, on the additional support services for new arrivals from the Mainland.

# Date of next meeting

- 10. <u>Members</u> noted that the next meeting was scheduled for Tuesday, 17 June 2008, at 10:45 am to consider all the Administration's responses to the outstanding issues raised by members. <u>The Administration</u> would also provide the full set of CSAs to be proposed by the Administration to the Bills Committee by the next meeting.
- 11. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 12:20 pm.
