The Bills Committee noted that the English and Chinese texts of the CSAs to be moved by the Administration (except for CSAs relating to Clause 46) were tabled at the meeting and CSAs relating to Clause 46 would be provided once available. 2. <u>Members</u> agreed that, as the Bills Committee had completed scrutiny of the marked-up version of the CSAs to be moved by the Administration at its last meeting, the legal adviser to the Bills Committee would study the English and Chinese texts of these CSAs and the Bills Committee would meet further if the legal and drafting aspects of these CSAs were found not in order. <u>Members</u> also agreed that the CSAs relating to Clause 46 to be moved by the Administration would be circulated to members once available.

- 3. <u>The legal adviser to the Bills Committee</u> was requested to revise the CSAs to be moved by the Chairman as follows -
  - (a) to amend Clause 10(3) by substituting "subsections (1) and (2)" with "subsection (2)";
  - (b) to delete the proposed new Clauses 58(1D) and 58(1E); and
  - (c) to amend the proposed Schedule 6 by substituting "Food and Health Bureau Health Branch" with "Food and Health Bureau" and adding "11. Social Welfare Department".

#### Action

4. <u>Members</u> noted that the inclusion of Social Welfare Department under Schedule 6 might render the relevant CSA to be considered as having a charging effect. <u>Members</u> agreed that, if the relevant CSA was ruled to be not admissible, the Chairman should proceed to move the relevant CSA by excluding Social Welfare Department from Schedule 6.

#### Resumption of Second Reading debate

- 5. <u>The Chairman</u> concluded that, while many members had strong reservations about the Bill, the Bills Committee in general did not object to the resumption of the Second Reading debate on the Bill on 9 July 2008 as proposed by the Administration.
- 6. <u>Members</u> agreed that the Chairman would make a verbal report on the deliberations of the Bills Committee to the House Committee (HC) on 20 June 2008, to be followed by submission of a written report to HC on 27 June 2008. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded members that the deadline for giving notice of CSAs was 28 June 2008.
- 7. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 12:40 pm.
