#### I. Election of Chairman

Mr LAU Kong-wah and Mr KWONG Chi-kin were elected Chairman and Deputy Chairman of the Bills Committee respectively.

2. The Bills Committee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

#### II. Meeting with the Administration

- 3. The Bills Committee requested the Administration -
  - (a) to explain the legal basis of enacting the Bill and provide relevant articles of the Constitution of the People's Republic of China as well as relevant documents issued by Mainland authorities;
  - (b) to explain the constitutional or legal basis of the decision of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress (NPCSC) on authorising the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region to exercise jurisdiction over the Hong Kong Port Area at the Shenzhen Bay Port referred to in Annex C to the Legislative Council (LegCo) Brief;
  - (c) to explain the constitutional or legal status of the NPCSC's decision "The Hong Kong Special Administrative Region is to

- administer the Hong Kong Port Area at the Shenzhen Bay Port as a closed area" in Annex C to the LegCo Brief;
- (d) to advise whether there were any Mainland laws that might prevail over NPCSC's decision;
- (e) to provide copies of the correspondences between the Administration and the Hong Kong Bar Association on the proposals in the Bill;
- (f) to explain the arrangements for repair and maintenance of the Shenzhen Section of Shenzhen Bay Bridge, including the bridge pier and relevant access roads, and advise how drivers would be made aware of the boundary of the Hong Kong Port Area;
- (g) to advise on the progress of discussions with the Shenzhen authorities on the land development and usage costs for the Hong Kong Port Area;
- (h) to provide information on similar arrangements, if any, in other jurisdictions on customs, immigration and quarantine clearance;
- (i) to advise on the process for announcement of the date of commencement of operation for the Shenzhen Bay Port by the State Council:
- (j) to confirm that Mainland laws would not apply in the Hong Kong Port Area;
- (k) to provide diagrams/plans indicating the boundary of the Hong Kong Port Area and to consider including such diagrams/plans in the Bill;
- (l) to explain the reasons and basis for determining the upper and lower vertical boundaries of various parts of the Hong Kong Port Area;
- (m) to consider setting out the upper and lower vertical boundaries of the Hong Kong Port Area in the lease to be signed between the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and the People's Government of the Shenzhen Municipality of Guangdong Province; and
- (n) to arrange a visit for the Bills Committee to the proposed Hong Kong Port Area.

4. The Bills Committee requested the Secretariat to circulate the relevant papers and minutes of the Finance Committee meetings in connection with the co-location arrangement referred to in the first paragraph of Annex F to the LegCo Brief.
