#### I. Meeting with the Administration

The Bills Committee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

- 2. The Bills Committee requested the Administration -
  - (a) to consider deleting clause 5(2) of the Bill;
  - (b) to provide the list of local legislation that applied only to the New Territories; and
  - (c) to explain the meaning of the phrase "to administer the Hong Kong Port Area at the Shenzhen Bay Port as a closed area" in paragraph 2(a) of the preamble and how it was to be implemented through local legislation.
- 3. The Administration advised that it would consider providing in clause 6 that, notwithstanding that the land within the Hong Kong Port Area was leased from the People's Government of the Shenzhen Municipality of Guangdong Province, the land was regarded, for the purpose of applying the laws of Hong Kong in the Hong Kong Port Area, as part and parcel of the Government land lying within Hong Kong.

- 4. The Administration also advised that it would provide a paper on issues relating to insurance policies in the proposed Hong Kong Port Area before the end of March 2007.
- 5. The Bills Committee agreed that the views of deputations would be sought on the implications of clause 6(1) and clause 8.

- 6. The Bills Committee noted that the next meeting would be held on 16 March 2007 at 10:45 am to continue discussion with the Administration.
