I. Meeting with the Administration

The Bills Committee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

- 2. The Bills Committee requested the Administration -
 - (a) to further explain its view that there was no need for the Decision of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress on Authorising the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) to Exercise Jurisdiction over the Hong Kong Port Area (HKPA) at the Shenzhen Bay Port (the NPCSC's Decision) to be included in Annex III to the Basic Law (BL); and
 - (b) to further explain its view that the NPCSC's Decision was intended to confer, for the purpose of Article 20 of BL (BL20), additional powers on the HKSAR.
- 3. The Administration advised that it would propose Committee Stage amendments to the Bill to deal with the expiry of the Bill when enacted.
- 4. <u>Ms Emily LAU</u> requested the Administration to state in the speech to be delivered by the Secretary for Security during the resumption of Second

Reading debate on the Bill that the additional powers conferred under BL20 would not deprive the rights of Hong Kong residents protected under BL.

- 5. The Bills Committee noted that the next meeting would be held on 24 March 2007 at 9:00 am to continue discussion with the Administration.
