I. **Meeting with the Administration**

[The Bill, LC Paper Nos. CB(2)1759/06-07(01), CB(2)1975/06-07(02), CB(2)2034/06-07(02) and (03), CB(2)2693/06-07(01) to (06), CB(2)2737/ 06-07(01) and LS101/06-07]

Proposed amendments to the Bankruptcy Ordinance (Cap. 6) (Part 2 of the Bill)

2. Members noted that the Administration proposed to withdraw Part 2 of the Bill by moving a Committee Stage amendment (CSA) on the ground that it intended to review the "abscondee" regime as a whole (i.e. bankrupts who left Hong Kong and could not be contacted) under the Bankruptcy Ordinance.

proposed legislative amendments to the "abscondee" regime, if any, would be undertaken in a separate exercise.

3. While expressing support for the Administration's proposal, <u>members</u> were concerned about the timeframe for introducing the proposed legislative amendments to the "abscondee" regime and whether public consultation would be conducted. <u>Members</u> agreed that the issue be referred to the Panel on Financial Affairs for follow up.

Proposed amendments to the Public Order Ordinance (Cap. 245) and the Societies Ordinance (Cap. 151) (Part 3 of the Bill)

- 4. <u>Members</u> noted the Administration's response to issues raised by members at the last meeting on 3 July 2007 regarding the proposed amendments to the Public Order Ordinance (POO) and the Societies Ordinance, and the paper prepared by the Legal Service Division of the Legislative Council Secretariat on the effect of not passing the proposed amendments in Part 3 of the Bill (LC Paper No. LS101/06-07).
- 5. <u>Members</u> considered that the Administration's response failed to sever the concept of "public order" (in law and order sense) from "public order (*ordre public*)" in the light of the Court of Final Appeal (CFA)'s judgment on the case of *Leung Kwok Hung & Others v HKSAR*. Given that the Administration had made its stance clear that no further amendment to the Bill was necessary and there had been lengthy discussion on the proposed amendments in Part 3 of the Bill at previous meetings, the Chairman suggested and members agreed that an internal meeting would be held to discuss whether the Bills Committee should propose amendments to Part 3 of the Bill. <u>The Chairman</u> added that the Administration was welcome to join the internal discussion. <u>The Chairman</u> also requested the legal adviser to the Bills Committee to prepare a list of provisions in the legislation which contained the term "public order (*ordre public*)" for members' consideration at the internal meeting.

Proposed amendments relating to wasted costs in criminal proceedings (Part 7 of the Bill)

6. <u>Members</u> noted that The Hong Kong Bar Association (Bar Association) had provided a further submission on Part 7 of the Bill concerning the proposed amendments relating to wasted costs in criminal proceedings. <u>The Administration</u> advised that it would need some time to study the proposals put forward by the Bar Association and would provide a written response later. <u>Members</u> agreed that discussion on Part 7 of the Bill would be held in abeyance pending the written response from the Administration. <u>Members</u> also agreed that —
