Six Members asked supplementaries and the Secretary for Security replied.

4. Hon Martin LEE asked Question 4.

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works replied.

Six Members asked supplementaries and the Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works replied.

5. Hon SIN Chung-kai asked Question 5.

The Financial Secretary replied.

Four Members asked supplementaries and the Financial Secretary replied.

6. Hon LAU Kong-wah asked Question 6.

#### Members' Motions

#### Leisure, gaming and entertainment complex

Hon James TIEN moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council urges the Government to actively study the feasibility of establishing a leisure, gaming and entertainment complex on Lantau, and to conduct extensive consultation in this regard.

While Hon James TIEN was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 1:10 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Question on Hon James TIEN's motion proposed.

The President's Deputy stated that Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit would move an amendment to the motion and that Hon Mrs Selina CHOW would also move an amendment to Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit's amendment. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion, the amendment, and the amendment to the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit moved the following amendment to Hon James TIEN's motion and addressed the Council:

To delete "to actively study" after "urges the Government" and substitute with ", before studying"; to delete "and to conduct extensive" after "entertainment complex on Lantau," and substitute with "to first look into the following three issues and conduct community-wide"; to delete "in this regard" after "consultation"; and to add ": (a) whether Hong Kong should maintain the existing policy of not encouraging gaming; (b) the cost-effectiveness of establishing a gaming and entertainment venue, as well as its impact on residents and environmental conservation; and (c) whether there is a need and any suitable location for a gaming and entertainment venue in Hong Kong" immediately before the full stop.

Question on Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit's amendment to Hon James TIEN's motion proposed.

Hon Mrs Selina CHOW moved the following amendment to Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit's amendment and addressed the Council:

To delete "three" after "look into the following"; to delete "and" after "environmental conservation"; and to add "; (d) the public revenue generated for Hong Kong, the number of job opportunities created, the benefits to the local economy and how far Hong Kong's competitiveness can be enhanced by establishing a leisure, gaming and entertainment complex; and (e) convention and exhibition facilities should be provided in the leisure, gaming and entertainment complex to meet future demands" immediately before the full stop.

Question on Hon Mrs Selina CHOW's amendment to Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit's amendment proposed.

Three Members and Hon CHAN Yuen-han spoke on the motion and the amendments.

At 2:05 pm while Hon CHAN Yuen-han was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

15 other Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon James TIEN spoke on the amendments.

The Secretary for Home Affairs spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Question on Hon Mrs Selina CHOW's amendment to Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit's amendment put.

Hon LEE Wing-tat claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 26 were present, 10 were in favour of the amendment, 13 against it and three abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 26 were present, two were in favour of the amendment, 16 against it and seven abstained. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Question on Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit's amendment to Hon James TIEN's motion put.

Hon CHAM Kam-lam claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 26 were present, 13 were in favour of the amendment, 10 against it and three abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 26 were present, four were in favour of the amendment, 13 against it and eight abstained. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was not greed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon James TIEN replied.

Question on Hon James TIEN's motion put.

Hon James TIEN claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 26 were present, 10 were in favour of the motion, 15 against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 27 were present, two were in favour of the motion and 24 against it. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

#### Electing the Chief Executive by universal suffrage

Hon Ronny TONG Ka-wah moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council considers the year 2012 appropriate for electing the Chief Executive by universal suffrage.

Question on Hon Ronny TONG Ka-wah's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon Howard YOUNG would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Howard YOUNG moved the following amendment to Hon Ronny TONG Ka-wah's motion and addressed the Council:

To delete "the year 2012 appropriate for electing the Chief Executive by universal suffrage" after "That this Council considers" and substitute with "that, should the pertinent conditions be ripe, meaning that there is a nominating committee which is broadly representative and acceptable to both the Central Government and Hong Kong, and the relationship between the Executive and the Legislature has been rationalized and is harmonious, this Council hopes that the election of the Chief Executive by universal suffrage will be held in 2012".

Question on Hon Howard YOUNG's amendment to Hon Ronny TONG Kawah's motion proposed.

Nine Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon LEE wing-tat drew the attention of the President to the absence of a quorum. The President directed the Clerk to summon Members to the meeting. A quorum was then present.

Four other Members and Hon Frederick FUNG Kin-kee spoke on the motion and the amendment.

While Hon Frederick FUNG Kin-kee was speaking, the President left the chair at 6:02 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung spoke on the motion and the amendment.

At 6:04 pm, while Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

While Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung was speaking, Hon LEE Cheuk-yan drew the attention of the President to the absence of a quorum. The President directed the Clerk to summon Members to the meeting. A quorum was then present.

Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung continued to speak.

One more Member and Hon Martin LEE spoke on the motion and the amendment.

While Hon Martin LEE was speaking, the President left the chair at 6:22 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Another four Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon Ronny TONG Ka-wah spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Constitutional Affairs spoke on the motion and the amendment.

At 6:57 pm while the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Question on Hon Howard YOUNG's amendment to Hon Ronny TONG Kawah's motion put.

Hon James TIEN claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 27 were present, eight were in favour of the amendment, 12 against it and seven abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 27 were present, two were in favour of the amendment, 17 against it and seven abstained. (Voting record in Appendix IV.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Ronny TONG Ka-wah replied.

Question on Hon Ronny TONG Ka-wah's motion put.

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 27 were present, seven were in favour of the motion, five against it and 15 abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 27 were present, 15 were in favour of the motion and 11 abstained. (Voting record in Appendix V.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.
