Members' Motions

1. Fugitive Offenders (Germany) Order and the Fugitive Offenders (Republic of Korea) Order

Hon James TO moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

RESOLVED that in relation to the -

- (a) Fugitive Offenders (Germany) Order, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 251 of 2006; and
- (b) Fugitive Offenders (Republic of Korea) Order, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 252 of 2006,

and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 22 November 2006, the period for amending subsidiary legislation referred to in section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) be extended under section 34(4) of that Ordinance to the meeting of 10 January 2007.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

2. Air Pollution Control (Volatile Organic Compounds) Regulation

Hon Audrey EU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

RESOLVED that in relation to the Air Pollution Control (Volatile Organic Compounds) Regulation, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 258 of 2006, and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 29 November 2006, the period for amending subsidiary legislation referred to in section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) be extended under section 34(4) of that Ordinance to the meeting of 17 January 2007.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Increasing the Government's share in the investment income of the Exchange Fund

Hon Howard YOUNG moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council urges the Government to revise the existing agreement between the Government and the Hong Kong Monetary Authority on the methodology for sharing the investment income of the Exchange Fund, so as to increase government revenue in this regard.

While Hon Howard YOUNG was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 1:25 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

While Hon Howard YOUNG was still addressing the Council, the Financial Secretary sought, with the President's Deputy permission, elucidation on a remark which the Member had just made. Hon Howard YOUNG elucidated and continued to address the Council.

Question on Hon Howard YOUNG's motion proposed.

The President's Deputy stated that Hon CHAN Kam-lam would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon CHAN Kam-lam moved the following amendment to Hon Howard YOUNG's motion and addressed the Council:

To delete "increase government revenue in this regard" after "so as to" and substitute with "allocate more investment income of the Exchange Fund to the Government, and ensure that there is stable government revenue from the investment income; in determining the level of additional investment income of the Exchange Fund to be allocated to the Government, the principle of keeping expenditure within the limits of revenues in drawing up the budget, striving to achieve a fiscal balance, avoiding deficits and keeping the budget commensurate with the growth rate of the gross domestic product must be strictly followed".

Question on Hon CHAN Kam-lam's amendment to Hon Howard YOUNG's motion proposed.

Eight Members and Hon Vincent FONG Kang spoke on the motion and the amendment.

At 2:42 pm, while Hon Vincent FONG Kang was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another four Members and Hon Albert CHAN spoke on the motion and the amendment.

While Hon Albert CHAN was speaking, he drew the attention of the President to the absence of a quorum. The President directed the Clerk to summon Members to the meeting. A quorum was then present.

Hon Albert CHAN continued to speak.

Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung spoke on the motion and the amendment.

While Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung was speaking, Hon James TO drew the attention of the President that the public officer concerned was not present in the Chamber. The President stated that the Rules of Procedure did not provide that the public officer concerned must be present in the Chamber when a motion debate was in progress. Hon James TO then drew the attention of the President to the absence of a quorum. The President directed the Clerk to summon Members to the meeting. A quorum was then present.

Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung continued to speak.

Hon Howard YOUNG spoke on the amendment.

The Financial Secretary spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Question on Hon CHAN Kam-lam's amendment to Hon Howard YOUNG's motion put and agreed to.

Hon Howard YOUNG replied.

Question on Hon Howard YOUNG's motion as amended by Hon CHAN Kam-lam put.

Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 22 were present, 21 were in favour of the motion as amended and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 21 were present, 18 were in favour of the motion as amended and two abstained. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion as amended was carried.

Urging the Central Government not to interfere in the HKSAR's internal affairs

Hon Emily LAU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council urges the Central Government not to interfere in the HKSAR's internal affairs, including the Chief Executive election, and urges the Administration to make every effort to defend the HKSAR's high degree of autonomy and Hong Kong people ruling Hong Kong under "one country, two systems".

Question on Hon Emily LAU's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon Howard YOUNG would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Howard YOUNG moved the following amendment to Hon Emily LAU's motion and addressed the Council:

To delete "not to interfere" after "Central Government" and substitute with "to continue to maintain the policy of not interfering"; and to delete ", including the Chief Executive election, and urges the Administration to" after "HKSAR's internal affairs" and substitute with "in accordance with the Basic Law, and requests the HKSAR Government to continue to".

Question on Hon Howard YOUNG's amendment to Hon Emily LAU's motion proposed.

Two Members and Hon Albert HO spoke on the motion and the amendment.

While Hon Albert HO was speaking, Hon Martin LEE drew the attention of the President to the absence of a quorum. The President directed the Clerk to summon Members to the meeting. A quorum was then present.

Hon Albert HO continued to speak.

Another one Member and Hon Martin LEE spoke on the motion and the amendment.

While Hon Martin LEE was speaking, Hon Emily LAU drew the attention of the President to the absence of a quorum. The President directed the Clerk to summon Members to the meeting. A quorum was then present.

Four more Members spoke on the amendment and the motion.

Hon Emily LAU spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Constitutional Affairs spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Question on Hon Howard YOUNG's amendment to Hon Emily LAU's motion put.

Hon SIN Chung-kai claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 21 were present, nine were in favour of the amendment, three against it and nine abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 26 were present, two were in favour of the amendment, 12 against it and 11 abstained. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Emily LAU replied.

Question on Hon Emily LAU's motion put.

Hon Albert HO claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 23 were present, four were in favour of the motion, 18 against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 26 were present, 15 were in favour of the motion and 10 against it. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

Next Meeting

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 10 January 2007 at 11:00 am.

The Council was adjourned at 6:25 pm.
