Bills

District Councils (Amendment) Bill 2006

Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which was moved on 20 December 2006 resumed.

Seven Members spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for Constitutional Affairs replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the **District** Councils (Amendment) Bill 2006.

Question that clauses 1 to 16 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

Third Reading

The Secretary for Constitutional Affairs reported that

the District Councils (Amendment) Bill 2006

had passed through the Committee without amendment. He moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

Motions

Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that the Air Pollution Control (Volatile Organic Compounds) Regulation, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 258 of 2006 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 29 November 2006, be repealed.

Question on the motion proposed.

Hon Audrey EU spoke on the motion as Chairman of the Subcommittee on Air Pollution Control (Volatile Organic Compounds) Regulation, and then in her personal capacity as a Member.

One Member spoke on the motion.

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works replied.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.

Members' Motions

Policy on conservation of monuments

Hon Audrey EU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, as the demolition of the Central Star Ferry Pier by the Government has aroused wide concern in the community, which reflects an increasing public awareness of and participation in the conservation of monuments, preservation of cultural environment and good town planning, this Council urges the Government to:

- (a) establish a monuments conservation fund to enhance the conservation of monuments;
- (b) formulate codes for the evaluation of social benefits and proper consultation procedures setting out in detail the cost-effectiveness of various options and their impact on monuments, having regard to the preservation of collective memories; and
- (c) enhance the participation of such concern groups as District Councils, professional bodies and resident groups in the decision-making process of town planning.

While Hon Audrey EU was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 2:33 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Question on Hon Audrey EU's motion proposed.

The President's Deputy stated that Hon WONG Kwok-hing, Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki, Hon CHOY So-yuk and Dr Hon YEUNG Sum would move amendments to the motion. Also, Hon Howard YOUNG and Hon Albert HO would move amendments to Hon WONG Kwok-hing's and Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki's amendments respectively. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendments would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon WONG Kwok-hing, Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki, Hon CHOY So-yuk, Dr Hon YEUNG Sum, Hon Howard YOUNG, Hon Albert HO and Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit spoke on the motion and the amendments.

At 3:40 pm, while Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

One other Member spoke on the motion and the amendments.

After declaring his interest that his company held the title to a house which had been included in the list of monuments, Hon LAU Wong-fat spoke on the motion and the amendments. Another 12 Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon Audrey EU spoke on the amendments.

The Secretary for Home Affairs spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon WONG Kwok-hing moved the following amendment to Hon Audrey EU's motion:

To add "policies and laws on the protection and conservation of antiquities and monuments in Hong Kong are imperfect, and the" after "That, as the"; to add "antiquities and" after "public awareness of and participation in the conservation to add "(a) reform the policies and laws on the protection and conservation of antiquities and monuments on the basis of comprehensive consultation, and formulate a timetable for legislative amendments;" after "this Council urges the Government to:"; to delete the original "(a)" and substitute with "(b)"; to delete "monuments conservation" after "establish a"; to add "on protection and conservation of antiquities and monuments" after "fund"; to add "protection and" after "to enhance the"; to add "antiquities and" after "conservation of"; to add ", as well as for repair, education and promotion work" after "monuments"; to delete the original and substitute with "(c)"; to add "antiquities and" after "various options and their impact on"; to delete ", having regard to the preservation of collective memories; and" after "monuments" and substitute with "(d) formulate criteria for the preservation of collective memories, community sights regional cultural characteristics;"; to delete original "(c) enhance" and substitute with "(e) establish a mechanism for"; to add "as well as the public" after "professional bodies and resident groups"; and to add "and community redevelopment; (f) consider adopting such means as land exchange and transfer of plot ratios to preserve more prevent them from being privately-owned monuments and demolished; (g) make reference to the sponsorship policies on monuments, including sponsorship antiquities and individuals, enterprises and communities, etc, which have been implemented for many years in such countries as the UK, the USA and France, so as to pave a new way for the protection and conservation of antiquities and monuments in Hong Kong; and draw from the successful experience in revitalizing antique buildings, such as the derelict industrial park on Vancouver's Granville Island, Japan's Otaru warehouses and the Taipei Story House, to promote multi-faceted development in humanities, history education, art, creative industries, tourism and community involvement, etc, thereby creating more employment opportunities" immediately before the full stop.

Question on Hon WONG Kwok-hing's amendment to Hon Audrey EU's motion proposed.

Hon Howard YOUNG moved the following amendment to Hon WONG Kwok-hing's amendment:

To add "providing economic incentives to private property owners, including" after "(f) consider"; to add "acquisition," after "adopting such means as"; and to add "," after "land exchange and transfer of plot ratios".

Question on Hon Howard YOUNG's amendment to Hon WONG Kwokhing's amendment proposed, put and agreed to.

Question on Hon WONG Kwok-hing's amendment, as amended by Hon Howard YOUNG, to Hon Audrey EU's motion put and agreed to.

As Hon WONG Kwok-hing's amendment as amended by Hon Howard YOUNG had been agreed, the President granted leave for Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki to revise the terms of his amendment and explain them to the Council.

Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki moved the following further amendment to Hon Audrey EU's motion as amended by Hon WONG Kwok-hing and Hon Howard YOUNG, and explained the revised terms of his amendment to the Council:

To add "; and (i) through reforming the Town Planning Board and relevant legislation, make the protection of monuments and preservation of cultural environment, etc the overriding principle in town planning in Hong Kong" immediately before the full stop.

Question on Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki's amendment to Hon Audrey EU's motion as amended by Hon WONG Kwok-hing and Hon Howard YOUNG proposed.

Hon Albert HO moved the following amendment to Dr Hon KWOK Kaki's amendment:

To add "one of" after "protection of monuments and preservation of cultural environment, etc"; and to delete "principle" after "the overriding" and substitute with "principles".

Question on Hon Albert HO's amendment to Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki's amendment proposed and put.

Hon Howard YOUNG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 24 were present, 10 were in favour of the amendment, seven against it and seven abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 23 were present, 15 were in favour

of the amendment, two against it and five abstained. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Miriam LAU rose to move the following motion without notice:

That in the event of further divisions in relation to the motion on "Policy on conservation of monuments" or amendments thereto, the Council do proceed to each of such divisions after the division bell has been rung for one minute.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Question on Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki's amendment to Hon Audrey EU's motion as amended by Hon WONG Kwok-hing and Hon Howard YOUNG put.

Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 25 were present, eight were in favour of the amendment, 10 against it and seven abstained; Members returned the by geographical amonq constituencies through direct elections, 24 were present, 10 were in favour of the amendment, eight against it and five abstained. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of present, she declared that the amendment Members negatived.

As Hon WONG Kwok-hing's amendment as amended by Hon Howard YOUNG had been agreed earlier, the President granted leave for Hon CHOY So-yuk to revise the terms of her amendment and explain them to the Council.

Hon CHOY So-yuk moved the following further amendment to Hon Audrey EU's motion as amended by Hon WONG Kwok-hing and Hon Howard YOUNG, and explained the revised terms of her amendment to the Council:

To add "; and (i) conduct a comprehensive and extensive consultation on the built heritage conservation policy and expeditiously formulate a proper built heritage conservation policy, with the aim of striking a balance between heritage conservation and urban development, so as to facilitate a sustainable and balanced development of the community" immediately before the full stop.

Question on Hon CHOY So-yuk's amendment to Hon Audrey EU's motion as amended by Hon WONG Kwok-hing and Hon Howard YOUNG proposed, put and agreed to.

As Hon WONG Kwok-hing's amendment as amended by Hon Howard YOUNG and Hon CHOY So-yuk's amendment had been agreed, the President granted leave for Dr Hon YEUNG Sum to revise the terms of his amendment and explain them to the Council.

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum moved the following further amendment to Hon Audrey EU's motion as amended by Hon WONG Kwok-hing, Hon Howard YOUNG and Hon CHOY So-yuk, and explained the revised terms of his amendment to the Council:

To add "; and (j) apart from the existing Antiquities Advisory Board, set up a statutory body on antiquities protection to take charge of related consultation and protection work (including compensation, land acquisition and conservation, etc), and allow the statutory body to directly acquire and operate any public or private monument items" immediately before the full stop.

Question on Dr Hon YEUNG Sum's amendment to Hon Audrey EU's motion as amended by Hon WONG Kwok-hing, Hon Howard YOUNG and Hon CHOY So-yuk proposed and put.

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 25 were present, 10 were in favour of the amendment, eight against it and seven abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 24 were present, 15 were in favour of the amendment, two against it and six abstained. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Audrey EU replied.

Question on Hon Audrey EU's motion as amended by Hon WONG Kwok-hing, Hon Howard YOUNG and Hon CHOY So-yuk put and agreed to.

Retaining and supporting the development of commercial districts and bazaars with local characteristics

Hon Vincent FANG Kang moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, as a number of Hong Kong's commercial districts and bazaars with local characteristics have been relocated due to the redevelopment of old areas and hence have fallen into decline, and the existence and development of many other similar commercial districts and bazaars are also facing the same threats, this Council urges the Government to:

- (a) retain the existing commercial districts and bazaars with local characteristics at the town planning stage;
- (b) formulate special management rules and regulations to balance the need to retain such commercial districts and bazaars and that for urban development and environmental hygiene; and
- (c) make reference to the practices of major cities in the Mainland and overseas, such as Singapore's Chinatown, London's Covent Garden and Shunde's Old Town district, and provide support and assistance through various policy bureaux for the development of such distinctive commercial districts and bazaars, so as to enhance their vitality, promote the local business economy and ensure that local characteristics are passed on.

While Hon Vincent FANG kang was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 6:09 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Question on Hon Vincent FANG Kang's motion proposed.

The President's Deputy stated that Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki and Dr Hon YEUNG Sum would move amendments to the motion and that Hon Albert HO would also move an amendment to Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki's amendment. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendments would be debated together in a joint debate.

Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki, Dr Hon YEUNG Sum, Hon Albert HO and two other Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Prof Hon Patrick LAU Sau-shing spoke on the motion and the amendments. At $7:02~\mathrm{pm}$, while he was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

12 more Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon Vincent FANG Kang spoke on the amendments.

The Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki moved the following amendment to Hon Vincent FANG Kang's motion:

To add "or cleared in recent years" after "have been relocated"; and to add ", with their integrity and in situ development as principles, and involve the participation of local residents and small traders in deciding the development or renewal plans, so as to facilitate sustainable development of the economy of the community" after "town planning stage".

Question on Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki's amendment to Hon Vincent FANG Kang's motion proposed.

Hon Albert HO moved the following amendment to Dr Hon KWOK Kaki's amendment:

To delete ", and involve the participation of" after "principles" and substitute with "as far as possible, and allow"; to delete "small" after "local residents and" and substitute with "affected"; and to delete "in deciding" after "traders" and substitute with "to participate in".

Question on Hon Albert HO's amendment to Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki's amendment proposed, put and agreed to.

Question on Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki's amendment, as amended by Hon Albert HO, to Hon Vincent FANG Kang's motion put and agreed to.

As Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki's amendment as amended by Hon Albert HO had been agreed, the President granted leave for Dr Hon YEUNG Sum to revise the terms of his amendment and explain them to the Council.

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum moved the following further amendment to Hon Vincent FANG Kang's motion as amended by Dr Hon KWOK Kaki's and Hon Albert HO, and explained the revised terms of his amendment to the Council:

To add ", and to enhance public consultation to allow greater public participation" after "facilitate sustainable development of the economy of the community".

Question on Dr Hon YEUNG Sum's amendment to Hon Vincent FANG Kang's motion as amended by Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki and Hon Albert HO proposed, put and agreed to.

Hon Vincent FANG Kang replied.

Question on Hon Vincent FANG Kang's motion as amended by Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki, Hon Albert HO and Dr Hon YEUNG Sum put and agreed to.
