Action

I. Confirmation of the minutes of the 21st meeting held on 20 April 2007 (LC Paper No. CB(2) 1687/06-07)

The minutes were confirmed.

II. Matters arising

Report by the Chairman on his meeting with the Chief Secretary for Administration

2. <u>The Deputy Chairman</u> said that there was nothing special to report.

III. Business arising from previous Council meetings

- (a) Legal Service Division report on bills referred to the House Committee in accordance with Rule 54(4)
 - (i) Civil Justice (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2007 (LC Paper No. LS 62/06-07)
- 3. <u>The Deputy Chairman</u> said that the Panel on Administration of Justice and Legal Services had been briefed on the legislative proposals.
- 4. <u>The Legal Adviser</u> said that the Legal Service Division recommended a Bills Committee be formed as the Panel had raised various issues of concern about the Bill.
- 5. <u>The Deputy Chairman</u> proposed that a Bills Committee be formed to study the Bill in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. The following Members agreed to join: Ms Margaret NG, Mr James TO and Mr Ronny TONG.
- 6. <u>The Deputy Chairman</u> said that as there were vacant slots, the Bills Committee could commence work immediately.

(ii) Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Bill 2007 (LC Paper No. LS 64/06-07)

- 7. <u>The Deputy Chairman</u> said that the Panel on Administration of Justice and Legal Services had been briefed on the legislative proposals and considered the formation of a Bills Committee necessary.
- 8. <u>The Legal Adviser</u> said that the Bill sought to provide for amendments to various Ordinances, and some of the proposed amendments were important and controversial. He referred Members to the Legal Service Division report which had set out some of the issues of concern.
- 9. <u>Ms Margaret NG</u> and <u>Mr Ronny TONG</u> expressed support for forming a Bills Committee. <u>Ms NG</u> said that when the Panel was consulted on the Bill, members had raised various issues of concern. She pointed out that some of the proposed amendments in the Bill were controversial, such as the proposed requirement for legal representatives to pay costs, and the proposed amendments to the Public Order Ordinance, the scope of which was too narrow.
- 10. <u>The Deputy Chairman</u> proposed that a Bills Committee be formed to study the Bill in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. The following Members agreed to join: Ms Margaret NG, Mr James TO, Ms Emily LAU and Mr Ronny TONG.
- 11. <u>The Deputy Chairman</u> said that as there were vacant slots, the Bills Committee could commence work immediately.
- (b) Legal Service Division report on subsidiary legislation gazetted on 20 April 2007 and tabled in Council on 25 April 2007
 (LC Paper No. LS 63/06-07)
- 12. <u>The Deputy Chairman</u> said that a total of three items of subsidiary legislation were gazetted on 20 April 2007 and tabled in Council on 25 April 2007.
- 13. <u>Members</u> did not raise any query on these three items of subsidiary legislation.
- 14. <u>The Deputy Chairman</u> reminded Members that the deadline for amending these items of subsidiary legislation was 23 May 2007.
