RE: Panel on Administration of Justice & Legal Services Meeting on 28th May 2007 at 4:30 p.m.

I refer to your letter dated 25th April 2007 in respect of the captioned matter. As regards Item IV (Budgetary Arrangement and Resources for the Judiciary), the Hong Kong Bar Association does not intend to send any representatives to attend that part of the meeting. (For the avoidance of doubt, a Mr. Gary Soo will attend on behalf of the Bar in respect of Item V – reform of the law of arbitration.)

However, insofar as may be necessary, the Bar will invite the Panel members to bear in mind the following matters when considering budgetary arrangement for the Judiciary:

- (1) Given the importance of the rule of law to Hong Kong, the Judiciary should be accorded as much flexibility as possible when considering its budgetary arrangement.
- (2) As a matter of principle, saving of costs should not be made at the expense of administration of justice.
