Proposed Amendments to the Attachment of Income Order (AIO) Legislation:

Supplementary information requested by Members at the LegCo Panel on Home Affairs Meeting held on 13 April 2007

Applicability of the AIO legislation to offices of the Central People's Government (CPG) in Hong Kong

The AIO legislation does not apply to offices of the Central Peoples Government (CPG) in Hong Kong. By virtue of Section 66 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1), an Ordinance does not bind the State¹ unless there is an express provision or necessary implication that the State is bound thereby. There is neither an express provision nor any necessary implication in the AIO legislation that the State is bound thereby.

Applicability of AIO legislation to local employees of consulates established in Hong Kong

2. An AIO is directed against an income source (by whom the income is payable). In the case of consular officers/employees, the income source for their posts would generally be their respective States. The AIO legislation does not have extra-territorial effect, and it does not

when acting within the scope of the delegated authority and the delegated functions of the subordinate organ concerned."

apply to an income source outside Hong Kong. As such, local employees of consulates established in Hong Kong are not subject to the AIO legislation.

Relevant findings of the Thematic Household Survey Report No. 29

3. At the request of the Home Affairs Bureau, a Thematic Household Survey (THS) managed by the Census and Statistics Department was conducted during June to August 2006 to collect information on enforcement of maintenance order. Some 10 000 households within a scientifically selected sample were successfully enumerated. Based on the information collected from the interviewed households, the situation related to all households and the entire population in Hong Kong was inferred. The relevant findings of the Thematic Household Survey Report on Enforcement of Maintenance Order are as follows –

Note: The figures were rounded to the nearest hundred for presentation purpose, but actual figures without rounding were used in compiling the percentage shares.

Reasons of unsuccessful applications for a maintenance order

4. As advised by the Judiciary, the court would decide whether or not to make a maintenance order having regard to the background and financial position of the parties concerned. The circumstances surrounding each application differ and the reasons for not making a maintenance order could not be generalized.

The number of cases in which the mechanism of enlisting the assistance of the Immigration Department in searching their records for the address of maintenance payers had been triggered to recover default maintenance payments.

5. There is an agreed arrangement between the Immigration Department (ImmD) and The Law Society of Hong Kong whereby if a

lawyer requires a maintenance payer's address for the purpose of taking legal action against the latter to recover maintenance arrears, the lawyer can request ImmD to search their records and provide the maintenance payer's address if available². As ImmD also accedes to requests from legal practitioners for release of personal records for various purposes (3 157 requests were acceded to in 2006), they did not maintain separate statistics on requests made for the purpose of enforcement of maintenance orders.
