I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman

Election of Chairman

Dr KWOK Ka-ki invited nominations for the chairmanship of the Panel for the 2006-2007 session in accordance with the election procedures set out in Appendix IV of the House Rules.

2. Ms LI Fung-ying nominated Dr Joseph LEE and Mrs Selina CHOW seconded the nomination. Dr Joseph LEE accepted the nomination.

3. There being no other nomination, Dr KWOK Ka-ki declared Dr Joseph LEE elected as the Chairman of the Panel.

Election of Deputy Chairman

4. Dr Joseph LEE took the chair and invited nominations for the deputy chairmanship of the Panel.

5. Mrs Selina CHOW nominated Dr KWOK Ka-ki and Ms LI Fung-ying seconded the nomination. Dr KWOK Ka-ki accepted the nomination.

6. There being no other nomination, the Chairman declared Dr KWOK Ka-Ki elected as the Deputy Chairman of the Panel.

II. Schedule of meetings for the 2006-2007 session

7. Members agreed to hold regular meetings on the second Monday of each month at 8:30 am. As the second Monday in April 2007 was a public holiday, members agreed to decide nearer the time whether the April meeting should be

held on 2 or 16 April 2007.

III. Discussion items for next meeting

8. The Chairman suggested and members agreed to decide after the meeting whether the following items proposed by the Administration should be discussed at the next regular meeting to be held on 13 November 2006 -

- (a) Progress report on promoting healthy eating habit among school children;
- (b) Registration of Chinese medicine practitioners; and
- (c) Subsidiary legislation to be made under the Human Reproductive Technology Ordinance.
