Background brief prepared by Legislative Council Secretariat for meeting on 7 November 2006

Police's handling of cases of violence against well-known personalities and civil servants in their performance of duties

Purpose

This paper gives a summary of past discussions held by the Panel on the Police's handling of cases of violence against well-known personalities and civil servants in their performance of duties.

Background

2. It was reported that in March 2004, Mr WONG Yuk-man, a radio programme host, was assaulted and his noodle shop was splashed with paint, and the premises of the company of Mr Albert CHENG, another radio programme host was also splashed with paint. In May 2004, Mr CHENG and Mr WONG announced respectively that they would be off the air. The Panel discussed how the Police would handle cases of intimidation or violence against public figures which might be related to their public comments.

Deliberations of the Panel on Security

Meeting of the Panel on Security on 13 May 2004

3. The Police's handling of cases of intimidation or violence against public figures and civil servants in their performance of duties was discussed at the meeting of the Panel on Security on 13 May 2004. Members were informed that the Police had identified 15 reported cases of well-known personalities subject to intimidation or violence in 2002 and 2003. Well-known personalities in this context included such persons as Legislative Council

- (LegCo) Members, public affairs commentators and social activists. In most of the cases, the motive behind the intimidation or violence could not be ascertained or substantiated by evidence. The Administration advised that there were 23, 21 and 30 cases of intimidation against civil servants in relation to their performance of duties in 2001, 2002 and 2003 respectively.
- 4. Members expressed concern that cases of intimidation or violence against public figures and civil servants in their performance of duties had a low detection rate. The Administration responded that the Police was committed to safeguarding and protecting life and property. However, there were practical difficulties in detecting some of the cases, as the motive behind the intimidation or violence might not be ascertained or substantiated by evidence. In some cases, the victim did not even know why he or she was assaulted.
- 5. Regarding violence against civil servants in their performance of duties, the Administration informed members that the injured civil servants were mainly from departments which had frequent contact with the public, such as the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (FEHD), the Department of Health and the Police. Where it was anticipated that an operation to be launched by such departments would encounter resistance from members of the public, joint operations with the Police would be considered.

Meeting of the Panel on Security on 25 May 2004

- 6. The Police's handling of cases of intimidation or violence against public figures which might be related to their comments was discussed at the meeting of the Panel on Security on 25 May 2004.
- 7. Members expressed concern whether the two recent cases of intimidation or violence against radio programme hosts would pose a threat to the freedom of speech in Hong Kong. Members questioned how the Police would investigate the cases and whether protection would be offered to the victims concerned.
- 8. The Administration stressed that the Police attached great importance to criminal acts against any public figures. On receiving reports of such cases, the Police would conduct careful and thorough investigation by taking statements from relevant parties, locating witnesses, gathering evidence at scenes of crime, establishing the culprits' profiles, and analysing their modus operandi. Depending on the evidence available and subject to legal advice, the Police might arrest and lay charges against the persons concerned. For one of the cases in question, the Police had arrested five persons. The Administration advised that investigations on the two cases were still underway, but there was so far no evidence to suggest that they were related to the public comments made by the two public figures.

- 9. The Administration informed members that between 1 January 2003 and 20 May 2004, there were 48 criminal cases against public figures, among which eight cases had been detected. The cases could be classified into criminal damage, criminal intimidation, assault, nuisance and request for Police investigation. Investigation of the background of the offenders in the cases detected revealed that most of the offenders were aged and lived near the scenes of crime. It was also revealed that the cases mainly involved mischief or venting of anger. Details of the eight detected cases provided by the Administration are in **Appendix I**.
- 10. The Administration assured members that the Police was committed to protecting the safety of the public, and would not tolerate any threat to public figures. The Police would provide appropriate protection to the witnesses and victims as necessary. The Police had been providing different levels of protection to one of the victims since the assault incident in 1998 and was discussing with him the protection arrangements.

Past cases of violence against well-known personalities and civil servants in the performance of duties

- 11. Some past cases of violence against well-known personalities and civil servant in their performance of duties reported by the media are as follows -
 - (a) former LegCo Member Mr Allen LEE Peng-fei was assaulted by three men in Shatin on 6 February 1990;
 - (b) Hon Albert CHENG was assaulted by three men on 8 September 1994 when he was a television programme host;
 - (c) Mr LEUNG Tin-wai, publication head of a weekly magazine, was assaulted by two men at his office on 15 May 1996;
 - (d) Hon Albert CHENG was assaulted by two men on 19 August 1998 when he was a radio programme host;
 - (e) Mr WONG Yuk-man, radio programme host, was assaulted by four persons in Tsimshatsui on 18 March 2004;
 - (f) former LegCo Member Mr WONG Sing-chi was assaulted at Sheung Shui Railway Station on 9 September 2004;
 - (g) three personnel of the FEHD were assaulted by 10 persons when performing duties in Shatin on 19 October 2004;
 - (h) Hon Albert HO was assaulted at his office in Tuen Mun on 27 June 2006:

- (i) Hon Albert HO was assaulted by three men at a fast-food restaurant in Central on 20 August 2006;
- (j) the Chairman of a minibus Association Mr LEUNG Hung was assaulted by two men in Shamshuipo on 30 August 2006; and
- (k) three FEHD personnel were assaulted by four hawkers when performing duties in Mongkok on 26 September 2006.

Follow-up on Meeting on 25 May 2004

At the meeting of the Panel on Security on 25 May 2004, Members requested the Administration to provide more information about the cases referred to in the Annex to Paper No. CB(2)2270/03-04(06).

10男女圍毆食環署三職員

【本報訊】食物環境衞生署兩男一女職員,昨晨八時在沙田正街街市對開處,擬票控一名 涉嫌隨地吐痰男子時,對方拒絕合作,並與食環署職員發生爭執,其間突有十名男女撲出 向他們包圍襲擊,三人同被毆傷,兇徒傷人後連同同伴逃去。警方接報到場兜截無果,將 傷者送院。

垃圾蟲吐痰拒合作

遇襲受傷兩男一女食物環境宪生署職員,分別姓張四十一歲,姓甄五十七歲及姓麥五十三歲(女),他們幸僅受輕傷,送院敷治後無礙。

事發於昨晨八時許,食物環境宪生署兩男一女職員,在沙田正街街市一帶執行捉垃圾蟲任務,當三人巡至街市對開處時,發現一名年約四十歲男子隨地吐痰,於是上前採取檢控時,對方拒絕合作,不肯出示身份證明文件,雙方因而發生爭執,並引動大批市民圍觀。

此時突有六男四女(三十至四十歲)撲出將食環署職員包圍及起哄,場面混亂,職員欲向 上級求援時,爲數近十名男女向他們三人圍毆,兇徒傷人後連同同伴逃去無蹤。

被打傷食環署職員通知上級及報警。警員接報趕抵兜截疑人無果,將三名傷者送院治療。 食環署發言人表示不作個別事件評論,但對於有市民違反公共地方潔淨而被檢控,市民應 予合作,不要作出違抗行為。

議員遇襲

政界強烈譴責暴行 李少光:絕不容忍 盡力緝兇

何俊仁遇襲事件引起各界高度關注,保安局局長李少光發表聲明,強烈譴責兇徒的暴力行為,而多名政界人士亦呼籲警方盡快破案,其中公民黨立法會議員梁家傑批評兇徒乃挑戰本港法治,民建聯副主席劉江華亦指事件令人震驚兼不能原諒,而過往亦有議員接獲恐嚇電話或信件,故希望警方加強保護議員。

何俊仁入院後,除行政長官曾蔭權往探望外,李少光昨晚亦發表聲明,強烈譴責兇徒的暴力行徑,並指本港是一個和平及法治的社會,政府絕不容忍這些暴力行為,他又指警方已展開嚴正的調查,會盡力緝拿兇徒歸案。

曾蔭權曾到醫院探望

劉江華昨探望何俊仁後亦指出:「在光天化日下,大街上有人打人,無論係唔係立法會議員都唔能夠容許」。他對何遇襲原因不予置評,但指問中亦有接獲電話騷擾,及在橫額遭寫上粗口,他雖曾多次向警方投訴,但警方均視爲平常事,故希望警方能更重視這些事件;民建聯議員蔡素玉亦表示:「唔同政見都好,咁嘅行爲係唔要得,市民要理性」。

梁家傑:暴行挑戰法治

公民黨議員梁家傑也譴責這類暴力行為,「香港係講道理嘅社會,唔能夠容許任何暴力 行為,尤其係有公職嘅立法會議員……香港係咪無法無天」?他指今次事件乃挑戰本港法 治,故要求警方重視。該黨另一議員湯家驊在探望何俊仁後指出,公民黨早前也接獲恐嚇 信件,警方仍在調查中,而是次何俊仁遇襲一事,較收到恐嚇更爲嚴重。

嶺南大學政治學及社會學系副教授李彭廣指出,過去亦有不少議員的宣傳版遭破壞,可能是因處理一些較敏感的政治議題時,引起持不同意見人士的不滿,而警方若最終調查發現是次事件與政見不同有關,估計與截取通訊條例有更直接關係。

學者:料與黑社會有關

城市大學專業進修學院首席講師宋立功則認為,何俊仁遇襲與黑社會勢力有關,而非政治問題,而市民及政黨也反對政治暴力,又認為以暴力對待政治人物的風氣不可長,警方有責任捉拿兇徒歸案。

過往亦曾發生議員受襲案件,如已逝世的民主黨前立法局議員吳明欽,85年仍爲屯門區議員時便曾遭十多名手持水喉鐵和利刀的大漢襲擊,導致胸背及臉部重創,他當時明言受襲與處理公共事務有關,更被形容爲民主流出「第一滴血」。而已退出本港政壇的前立法會議員李鵬飛,90年亦遭兇徒打傷,留醫十小時,而現任立法會議員鄭經翰未晉身議會時,更遭兇徒狂斬六刀,筋骨亦被斬斷,警方與商台懸紅400萬元緝兇,但至今未將兇徒繩之以法。



劉江華:令人震驚

公民黨立法會議員湯家驊表示,這次襲擊事件十分嚴重,是兇徒有意挑戰本港法治,要求警方加倍 重視及加緊調查;而該黨也曾接獲恐嚇信,事件仍 在調查中。

另外,當何俊仁遇襲後,陸續有多位民主黨黨員 到醫院探望,包括前主席李柱銘、立法會議員單仲 偕等。主席李永達表示,民主黨譴責今次襲擊,暫 時未知動機,相信不涉及私人恩怨:「這麼短時 間,如此乾淨利落的手法去襲擊一個立法會議員、 民主黨副主席,我覺得是一件很嚴重的事。」

李華明則懷疑事件是有預謀的,並對暴力行為感到氣憤。他續說,幾名施襲男子將帽拉低,令其他人認不出他們的樣貌。故相信襲擊不是無意識的行為,故懷疑是有預謀的;而施襲的疑兇亦預先知道遊行完畢,將會看到何俊仁。



名人遇襲案

本港屢見難緝兇

立法會議員何俊仁昨於中環隔市遭3 名手持木棍的大漢襲擊,事件惹來各界

關注。其實,名人遭受恐嚇及暴力襲擊,在本港已多次發生,當中最為轟動者包括96年梁天偉捱刀案、98年鄭經翰被斬案及04年黃毓民遇襲案,每次都引起傳媒及公眾的高度關注,也都幾乎每次都無法偵破。



梁天偉捱刀斷兩指

1996年5月15日,現任樹仁學院新 開與傳播學系系主任、資深新聞工作者梁天偉在辦公室 內,為所負責的周刊進行出版前夕工作。兩名身穿西裝的 男子走到梁天偉的辦公室,聲稱與他傾談印刷事宜。其

後,兩漢突然拿出藏在身後的牛肉 刀,向梁狂砍。結果,梁天偉身中 九刀,其左前臂和兩根手指被砍 斷,身上中的一刀亦傷及肺部,經 手術後始逐漸康復。

1998年8月19日清晨時分,現任立 法會議員鄭經翰如常駕車返回廣播 道商業電台上班時,在停車場內突 遭兩名兇徒以利刀作放血式狂斬,



造成手腳、背部六個大傷口,部分筋骨亦被斬斷,鄭重傷 昏迷送院,幾乎喪命。

鄭大班被斬險送命

2004年3月16日,黄毓民在尖沙咀金巴利道街頭遭4名男

子襲擊,但黃並無大礙,其後自行致電報警。事發前,黃毓民的牛肉麵店與另一商台節目主持人鄭經翰的公司皆被潑紅色漆油搗亂。同年5月13日,黃毓民疑因其家人受到黑社會恐嚇,突然宣佈封咪離港;出走前只在電話中留下「身心俱疲,需要休息」信息作交代。

電視訪問抨超速兩煞扁鐵扑頭 小巴商會主席遇襲浴血

本港戾氣瀰漫,繼何俊仁遇襲事件後,昨又有另一公眾人物慘遭伏擊。擁有二千名會員的「小巴總商會」主席梁雄,接受電視訪問批評小巴司機超速後,返回深水埗商會大廈地下大堂,竟被兩名兇徒從後用扁鐵猛力仆頭襲擊,頭破血流。兩煞逞兇後,即棄下利器,施展「金蟬脫殼」,掉下外衣,乘的士逃去。警方對案件極表重視,不容再有人以暴力解決問題,即時將案交由西九龍重案組接手,追緝兩名二十餘歲兇徒。

「小巴總商會」主席梁雄,昨批評小巴司機開快車後遇襲受傷。傷者梁雄(七十歲),是香港九龍新界公共專綫小型巴士聯合總商會主席,他頭部、前額、左手及左腳受傷,送院縫了五針,昨晚離開明愛醫院轉到私家醫院留醫,情況穩定。

穿頭縫針夜轉私院

梁在六十年代加入小巴行業並組織商會,過去常接受訪問發表意見,昨日中午,梁接受電視台新聞節目訪問,批評個別小巴司機,漠視車速顯示器及開快車,他說:「已經有個響聲預先警告畀你,你都唔去遵守,舊時無,就話唔知,依家有,就要遵守。」

據悉,昨午四時三十分,梁返回出任主席,位於福華街一七四號德寶大廈的商會,當進入大廈地下大堂梯口,即被兩名跟蹤而至的大漢襲擊,兩兇徒各持一支用報紙包裹長約十八吋、闊約兩吋及厚約兩分的扁鐵擊向梁的頭部,梁轉身察看再被重擊,舉起左手圖擋格,前額及手腳受傷倒地,鮮血染紅衣襟。兇徒傷人後,其中一人曾失足跌倒,起身後繼續逃走,在大廈門口棄掉一支扁鐵,由福榮街轉入一條橫巷,再將其餘一支扁鐵拋到大廈天井,其中一匪脫下黑色T恤掉在巷口,兩人逃至福榮街,經九江街跑至元州街,截乘的士逃去。

重案組接手不涉會務

大廈看更見血案發生迅即報警,商會秘書聞訊亦趕來搶救,警方與救護員到場替傷者包紮,再送明愛醫院治理,梁送院時仍清醒,向警方稱無與人結怨亦無欠債,不知爲何遇襲。

警方在大廈及橫巷,檢獲兩支扁鐵、一件T值及一個疑用來盛載扁鐵的紙手抽,警方又向看更錄取資料,由於傷者遇襲前曾公開批評小巴司機開快車,警方對案件極表重視,列作傷人案,由西九重案組接手。經初步調查,警方掌握兩名兇徒的資料,他們年約二十餘歲至三十歲,身高約五呎五吋至五呎七吋,分別穿黑色及白色T恤,短髮,其中一人有紋身。
