ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) (ADDITION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS) REGULATION 2007

(Made by the Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works under section 11 of the Road Traffic Ordinance (Cap. 374))

1. Commencement

This Regulation shall come into operation on 23 June 2007.

2. Failure to comply with traffic signs and road markings


Regulation 59(1)(a) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations (Cap. 374 sub. leg. G) is amended by repealing "168 and 169" and substituting "168, 169, 170, 171, 172 and 173".

3. Traffic signs




LANE SIGNAL




LANE SIGNAL

THIS SIGN WHEN DISPLAYED ABOVE A TRAFFIC LANE INDICATES THAT VEHICLES SHALL NOT PROCEED BENEATH OR BEYOND THE SIGN IN THAT LANE IN THE DIRECTION OPPOSITE TO THAT IN WHICH THE SIGN FACES.

PROCEED LEFT OR KEEP LEFT


THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW MAY BE REVERSED TO INDICATE—

VARIABLE SPEED LIMIT
