- 2. The Administration was requested to -
 - (a) consider holding a franchisee under Schedule 4 liable in the event of non-compliance with the relevant provisions in the Bill;
 - (b) include in the speech to be delivered by the Secretary for the Environment an undertaking for the Administration to consult the affected trades with a view to working out a reasonable percentage of wastage for plastic shopping bags for accounting purpose;
 - (c) review clause 25 and consider setting a higher threshold for the Director to serve an assessment notice. For example, an assessment notice could only be served after a registered retailer had been found guilty of an offence under clause 9. To also provide the Irish legislation on which clause 25 was modeled and details of implementation by the Irish Government;
 - (d) set out the course of actions which the Administration would take against a registered retailer who failed to submit returns or provided false information; and
 - (e) review the Chinese rendition of clause 27 and the proposed Committee Stage amendments to clauses 7(2) and 8.
- 3. <u>Members</u> agreed to continue discussion at the next meetings scheduled for Thursday, 12 June 2008, at 2:30 pm and 4:30 pm.
