<u>Ir Dr Raymond HO</u>, the member who had the highest precedence among members of the Bills Committee, presided over the election of Chairman of the Bills Committee. He invited nominations for the chairmanship.

- 2. <u>Dr Philip WONG</u> nominated Mrs Selina CHOW and the nomination was seconded by <u>Mr Howard YOUNG</u>. <u>Mrs Selina CHOW</u> accepted the nomination. <u>Ms Emily LAU</u> nominated Mr Alan LEONG and the nomination was seconded by <u>Ms Audrey EU</u>. <u>Mr Alan LEONG</u> accepted the nomination. As there were two nominations, <u>members</u> cast their votes by secret ballot. <u>Mrs Selina CHOW</u> received 15 votes and <u>Mr Alan LEONG</u> received six votes. <u>Ir Dr Raymond HO</u> declared that Mrs Selina CHOW was elected Chairman of the Bills Committee. Mrs Selina CHOW then took over the chair.
- 3. The Chairman solicited members' views on the need for a Deputy Chairman. At the suggestion of Ms Emily LAU and with the agreement of members, the Chairman invited nominations for a deputy chairman. Ms Emily LAU nominated Mr Alan LEONG and the nomination was seconded by Ms Audrey EU. Mr Alan LEONG accepted the nomination. Mr Jeffrey LAM nominated Mr CHEUNG Hok-ming and the nomination was seconded by Mr Jasper TSANG. Mr CHEUNG Hok-ming accepted the nomination. As there were two nominations, members cast their votes by secret ballot. Mr Alan LEONG received four votes and Mr CHEUNG Hok-ming received 14 votes. The Chairman declared that Mr CHEUNG Hok-ming was elected Deputy Chairman of the Bills Committee.

- 4. The Bills Committee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).
- 5. The Administration was requested to provide written response on the following points raised by individual members of the Bills Committee --
 - (a) Would the Administration consider articulating mission statements for the West Kowloon Cultural District Authority (WKCDA) and incorporating such mission statements into the Bill so as to provide objective yardsticks for the public and the Legislative Council

(LegCo) to continuously scrutinize the Authority's work?

- (b) While the Administration considered it not appropriate to specify the precise composition of Board members in the Bill, would the Administration consider specifying the criteria, such as the backgrounds and the qualities possessed, for the appointment of the non-public officer members of the WKCDA Board?
- (c) Would the Administration consider appointing some of the non-public officer Board members in representative capacities instead of on an ad personam basis? In this regard, the Bill might provide that the LegCo Member(s) to be appointed to the Board were to be elected by and from among the LegCo Members. For those Board members from the professional sectors, the Bill might provide for an election mechanism linked to the relevant subsectors represented on the Chief Executive Election Committee. For those Board members from the arts and cultural sectors, the Bill might provide for an election mechanism linked to the Sports, Performing Arts, Culture and Publication functional constituency of the LegCo.
- (d) Would the Administration consider specifying in the Bill that the meetings of the Board and committees of WKCDA should be open to the public except under certain specified circumstances? The relevant provisions in the Town Planning Ordinance (Cap. 131) might serve as the reference.
- (e) Would the Administration consider providing in the Bill the establishment of statutory consultation panels comprising representatives from various stakeholder groups and members of the public? In this regard, it had been suggested that while WKCDA should be obliged to engage the panels in the form of open meetings, the opinions of the panels and their members would not bind WKCDA.
- (f) To ensure that the Audit Committee could play an effective financial monitoring role, would it be appropriate to specify in the Bill that the members of the Audit Committee should not include those persons who would make or execute decisions on the expenditure of the WKCDA?
- (g) Would the Administration consider including relevant provisions in the Bill to the effect that the six-year six-board rule would be applicable to WKCDA Board members?
- (h) It had been suggested that a system with the most stringent requirements for disclosure of interest should apply to the members

- of the Board and committees of WKCDA. Would the Administration consider this suggestion and how such a system should be reflected in the legislation?
- (i) It had been suggested that for the purpose of good governance, there should be a mechanism for determining the remuneration package for senior executives of WKCDA and for disclosure of their remuneration packages. Would the Administration consider this suggestion and how the relevant arrangements should be reflected in the legislation?

6. <u>Members</u> agreed that organizations and individuals that had provided views to the Subcommittee on West Kowloon Cultural District Development on the proposals in relation to the establishment of a statutory body to take forward the West Kowloon Cultural District (WKCD) project and the 18 District Councils would be invited to present views. A press release would be issued and a general notice would be put up on the website of LegCo.
