Ying Wa Girls' School 英華女學校 The views of the Grant Schools Council (GSC) on the Consultation Document on the Third Strategy on information Technology in Education:

- Although the GSC supports the government's proposal to establish
  a \$5 million central IT support centre to back up all the schools in
  Hong Kong, there is an urgent need to add a new post "IT
  Coordinator" to the normal staff entitlement. This new post should
  enjoy promotion prospects.
- The \$200,000,000 budget for IT education for 5 years is insufficient, considering the fact that there are over 1000 primary and secondary schools in Hong Kong. Another sum of money should also be set aside to help schools to replace the old computers in school.
- Secondary school students should be given the same privilege as university students of a laptop personal computer per head.
