Pay Adjustment Cycles for Non-Civil Service Contract staff

Purpose

This paper provides supplementary information regarding the pay adjustment cycles for Non-Civil Service Contract (NCSC) staff.

Supplementary information

- 2. During the discussion on the pay adjustment arrangements for NCSC staff in the eight main user bureaux/departments (B/Ds)¹ of the NCSC Staff Scheme on 17 December 2007, Members asked the Administration to provide information regarding the pay adjustment cycles for their NCSC staff.
- 3. B/Ds conduct periodic reviews on the pay of their NCSC staff to ensure that it remains competitive with the prevailing pay levels in the market place, and enables them to recruit and retain NCSC staff. Reviews are conducted at different times of a year. Where justified, pay revisions are implemented on a prospective date after the conclusion of pay reviews and/or upon contract renewal of serving NCSC staff. In the past three years (i.e. from 2005 to 2007), the pay adjustment effective dates adopted by the eight main user B/Ds are set out below -
