LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL PANEL ON TRANSPORT Use of Laser Guns

At the meeting of the Panel on Transport held on 22 February 2008, Members requested information about the prosecutions for speeding detected with laser guns in the past three years which were detected by the two police officers [the laser gun operators] involved in the Peter Lam and Tino Kwan cases.

The laser gun operator in the LAM Case [court reference No. TWS 5276/07] was SPC 9205, who was attached to E&C T NTS between 8 May 2005 and 9 December 2007. The laser gun operator in the KWAN Case [court reference No. TWS 19678/05] was SPC 1965, who was attached to E&C T NTS between 6 September 2004 and 15 January 2008, when he proceeded on pre-retirement leave.

The chart below provides details of the only cases detected by these two officers, which proceeded to Court, in the period 1 January 2005 to 22 February 2008.¹
