1. Commencement

This Regulation shall come into operation on 27 December 2007.

2. Qualifications for registration

 - (2) Regulation 4 is amended by adding—
 - "(eb) holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Medical Laboratory Science awarded by The Hong Kong Polytechnic University; or".

3. Qualifications and experience for entry in various parts of the register

- (1) Regulation 5(a) is amended by repealing "(e) or (ea)" and substituting "(e), (ea) or (eb)".
- (2) Regulation 5(b)(i) is amended by repealing "(e) or (ea)" and substituting "(e), (ea) or (eb)".
