Explanatory Note

This Order adds two provisions to Schedule 3 to the Electronic Transactions Ordinance (Cap. 553). The effect is that a document required or permitted to be served on a person by personal service or post under these two provisions may be served in the form of an electronic record. The electronic record must be sent to an information system designated by the person, and the information in it must be accessible for subsequent reference.
