# ANTIQUITIES AND MONUMENTS (DECLARATION OF HISTORICAL BUILDINGS) (NO. 2) NOTICE 2007

(Made by the Secretary for Development under section 3(1) of the Antiquities and Monuments Ordinance (Cap. 53) after consultation with the Antiquities Advisory Board and with the approval of the Chief Executive)

#### 1. Commencement

This Notice shall come into operation on 1 February 2008.

### 2. Declaration of historical buildings

The following are declared to be historical buildings—

- (a) the building known as Tang Ancestral Hall on Ha Tsun Shi Lot No. 44 in D.D. 125 and Lot No. 1722 in D.D. 125, Ha Tsuen, Yuen Long, New Territories, and its adjoining land, delineated and shown edged red on the plan marked Plan No. YLM6911 signed and deposited in the Land Registry under section 3(4) of the Ordinance by the Secretary for Development; and
- (b) all other buildings on such land (other than the structure on the area hatched black on the plan).

## **Explanatory Note**

This Notice declares the building known as Tang Ancestral Hall and the adjoining land and some other buildings at Ha Tsuen, Yuen Long, New Territories, to be historical buildings for the purposes of the Antiquities and Monuments Ordinance (Cap. 53).
