## Members' Motions

# <u>Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General</u> Clauses Ordinance

Hon Fred LI moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

RESOLVED that in relation to the Harmful Substances in Food (Amendment) Regulation 2008, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 215 of 2008 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 8 October 2008, the period for amending subsidiary legislation referred to in section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) be extended under section 34(4) of that Ordinance to the meeting of 26 November 2008.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

# Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance

Hon Miriam LAU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

RESOLVED that in relation to the Road Traffic (Public Service Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulation 2008, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 219 of 2008 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 8 October 2008, the period for amending subsidiary legislation referred to in section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) be extended under section 34(4) of that Ordinance to the meeting of 26 November 2008.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

## Motion of Thanks

Hon Miriam LAU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council thanks the Chief Executive for his address.

Question on the motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon Emily LAU would move an amendment to the motion, and that the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

According to the arrangements endorsed by the House Committee, Members should confine their speeches in a session to the policy areas specified for that session, so that the debate would be more focused, and the designated public officers concerned could immediately respond to Members' views within the session.

The President further stated that some Members had indicated that they did not wish to confine their speeches in a particular session to the policy areas specified for that session. He did not intend to strictly enforce the above requirement but would like to remind Members that if they did not follow the House Committee's arrangements in making their speeches, the designated public officers concerned would not be able to listen to their views on the relevant policy areas and then respond in that session. He hoped that Members would speak according to the original arrangements.

The President announced the commencement of the first debate session, which covered the policy areas of commerce and industry, economic development (other than energy), financial affairs (financial services), housing, information technology and broadcasting (other than creative industry), development (planning, lands and works) and transport.

Nine Members and Hon Emily LAU spoke.

While Hon Emily LAU was speaking, the President left the chair at 1:34 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Hon Jeffrey LAM spoke and declared that he was the Chairman of the Advisory Board of the Hong Kong Export Credit Insurance Corporation.

Three more Members and Dr Hon LAM Tai-fai spoke.

At 2:54 pm, while Dr Hon LAM Tai-fai was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Fourteen other Members and Hon Paul TSE spoke.

While Hon Paul TSE was speaking, the President left the chair at 6:33 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Three more Members and Hon James TO spoke.

At 7:50 pm, while Hon James TO was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another five Members spoke.

The President suspended the meeting at 9:13 pm.

\* \* \* \* \* \*

The Council resumed at 9:00 am on 30 October 2008 to continue the first debate session of the Motion of Thanks.

Noting the absence of a quorum, the President directed the Clerk to summon Members to the meeting. A quorum was then present.

Four Members spoke.

The Financial Secretary and the Secretary for Development spoke.

While the Secretary for Development was speaking, Hon Albert HO requested the Secretary to elucidate a Member's name mentioned in her speech.

The Secretary for Development elucidated and continued to speak.

The Secretary for Transport and Housing and the Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury spoke.

The President announced the end of the first debate session and the commencement of the second debate session, which covered the policy areas of economic development (energy), environmental affairs, food safety and environmental hygiene, home affairs (other than district administration and civic education), information technology and broadcasting (creative industry) and development (heritage conservation).

Ten Members and Hon Albert CHAN spoke.

While Hon Albert CHAN was speaking, the President left the chair at 1:08 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Six other Members and Dr Hon Samson TAM spoke.

At 2:35 pm, while Dr Hon Samson TAM was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Six more Members spoke.

The Secretary for the Environment, the Secretary for Development, the Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development, the Secretary for Food and Health and the Secretary for Home Affairs spoke.

The President announced the end of the second debate session and the commencement of the third debate session, which covered the policy areas of manpower, welfare services (including social enterprise and family matters) and financial affairs (allocation of public resources).

Six Members and Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG spoke.

While Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG was speaking, the President left the chair at 6:28 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Fred LI, took the chair.

Six more Members and Hon IP Wai-ming spoke.

At 7:29 pm, while Hon IP Wai-ming was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Four more Members spoke.

The Secretary for Labour and Welfare, the Secretary for Home Affairs and the Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury spoke.

The President announced the end of the third debate session and suspended the meeting at 8:39 pm.

\* \* \* \* \* \* \*

The Council resumed at 9:00 am on 31 October 2008 to commence the fourth debate session of the Motion of Thanks.

The President announced the commencement of the fourth debate session, which covered the policy areas of education, health services and security (immigration policies).

Twenty-three Members spoke.

The Secretary for Education, the Secretary for Food and Health and the Secretary for Security spoke.

The President announced the end of the fourth debate session and the commencement of the fifth debate session, which covered the policy areas of administration of justice and legal services, constitutional affairs, public service, security (other than immigration policies) and home affairs (district administration and civic education).

One Member and Prof Hon Patrick LAU spoke.

While Prof Hon Patrick LAU was speaking, the President left the chair at 12:45 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Three other Members and Hon LEE Wing-tat spoke.

At 1:12 pm, while Hon LEE Wing-tat was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Two more Members and Hon Abraham SHEK spoke.

With the President's permission, Dr Hon Margaret NG elucidated a point she had made earlier which she considered to be misunderstood by Hon Abraham SHEK.

Ten more Members and Hon IP Kwok-him spoke.

While Hon IP Kwok-him was speaking, Hon Emily LAU sought, with the President's permission, elucidation by Hon IP Kwok-him of a point raised in his speech.

Hon WONG Kwok-kin raised a point of order that a Member should not interrupt another Member who was speaking. The President requested Hon WONG Kwok-kin to take his seat and asked Hon IP Kwok-him to continue to speak.

Hon IP Kwok-him elucidated and continued to speak.

Another Member spoke.

Hon Paul CHAN declared that he was the Chairman of the Legal Aid Services Council and spoke.

Two more Members spoke.

The Chief Secretary for Administration, the Secretary for Justice and the Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs spoke.

While the Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs was speaking, Hon Emily LAU sought elucidation of a point raised by the Secretary in his speech. The President stated that in accordance with the Rules of Procedure, while another Member or a public officer was speaking, a Member might elucidate, if the Member or public officer speaking was willing to give way. The Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs continued to speak.

The Secretary for the Civil Service, the Secretary for Security and the Secretary for Home Affairs spoke.

The President announced the end of the fifth debate session.

Hon Miriam LAU spoke on the amendment.

Hon Emily LAU moved the following amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion:

To add ", but as many people support the implementation of dual universal suffrage in 2012, this Council expresses deep regret at the Chief Executive's remark that the timetable for universal suffrage set by the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress at the end of 2007 enjoys wide support in the community, which disregarded the request for the implementation of dual universal suffrage in 2012 from the community at large" immediately before the full stop.

Question on Hon Emily LAU's amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion proposed and put.

Hon Emily LAU claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 27 were present, four were in favour of the amendment, 21 against it and two abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 29 were present, 18 were in favour of the amendment and 10 against it. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, he declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Miriam LAU replied.

Question on the motion put.

Hon Albert CHAN claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 27 were present, 25 were in favour of the motion, one against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 29 were present, 22 were in favour of the motion and six against it. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, he declared that the motion was carried.

# Next Meeting

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 5 November 2008 at 11:00 am.

The Council was adjourned at 4:34 pm.
