<u>The Subcommittee</u> deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

Views expressed by the deputations

2. <u>The Subcommittee</u> noted the following views expressed by deputations at the meeting –

- (a) <u>Fare adjustments and the new taxi fare structure under the</u> <u>Amendment Regulation</u>
 - The Lantau taxi trade generally agreed with the fare adjustments and the new taxi fare structure, which was front-loaded and thereafter on a varying descending scale of incremental charges (the new fare structure). The Lantau Taxi Association stressed that taxi operators in Lantau looked forward to the implementation of the fare adjustments to relieve the pressure of escalating operating costs.
 - There were dissenting views from different stakeholders of the urban taxi trade on the implementation of the new fare structure and fare adjustments. The majority of the deputations were in support of the fare adjustments and called on the Subcommittee to support the Amendment Regulation to enable the implementation of the fare adjustments on 30 November 2008.
 - The Taxi Driver & Operators Association Ltd expressed strong objection to the fare adjustments and the new fare structure, stating its view that the fare adjustments would largely reduce the income of rentee-drivers, in light of the economic downturn amidst the recent financial tsunami. It requested that the existing fare level for urban taxis be maintained.
 - The Hong Kong Taxi Association urged the Subcommittee to give due consideration to the lack of consensus among the urban taxi trade on the new fare

structure and suggested the implementation of the increase in flagfall charge from \$16 to \$18 initially, pending further discussion among different stakeholders of the trade to reach a consensus on the fare structure.

(b) Impact of the fare adjustments on income of taxi operators

- The Taxi Driver & Operators Association Ltd stated that in light of the recent financial tsunami, the fare adjustments and new fare structure would have adverse impact on the operating environment of the taxi trade, thereby reducing the income of rentee-drivers. Moreover, rentee-drivers would face greater pressure of the rising operating cost as taxi rentals would increase after the fare adjustments.
- Deputations representing the rentor-owners stated that they would monitor changes in the operating revenue of taxi drivers during the initial months (for a period of around three to six months) of implementation of the fare adjustments, before deciding on any adjustments of the taxi rentals. They pointed out that taxi rentals were determined by the forces of demand and supply in the taxi rental market, rather than being dominated by rentor-owners.

(c) <u>Prohibition against fare bargaining</u>

- Most deputations considered that introduction of the new fare structure could help curtail discount gang activities by minimizing the scope for discount offers. While supportive of enacting legislation to prohibit fare bargaining by passengers (the legislative prohibition), they were concerned that enactment of the relevant legislation might delay implementation of the fare adjustments under the Amendment Regulation if the two proposals were taken forward in a bundle. They considered that the proposal for the legislative prohibition should be pursued separately at a later stage.
- Mr CHENG Cho-kwong, Shatin District Councillor, Taxi Dealers & Owners Association Limited, and Hong Kong Taxi Association considered the legislative prohibition necessary for restoring a level playing field

for taxi operators and requested for the early introduction of the relevant legislation.
