Dear Mr. Lee.

Product Eco-responsibility (Plastic Shopping Bags) Regulation

I refer to your reply on 18 February 2009 on the captioned and to HPD's second Working Group meeting with the trade on 24 February 2009 and would like to respond as follows:

(a) Third Party Operation

We maintain that it is not a usual practice for concessionaire to operate under a separate business registration at "the location in question", as the concessionaire usually operates under a Business Registration with an address of its head office. We are of the view that a certified true copy of the third party operator is sufficient to establish the fact that a third party operation is indeed not carried out by a registered retailer.

(b) Figures on plastic shopping bags

Repeatedly, we have queried the accuracy of EPD's estimation of a 1 billion bags reduction and presented actual figures based on the industry's statistics. But we are disappointed that your department has never provided further information or explanation.

The industry believes that the Government's figures are incorrect. Based on figures available to HKRMA, affected retailers distribute about BM million plastic shopping bags each year. Accordingly, even if affected retailers did not give away any bags, the reduction could not possibly be one billion. HKRMA finals that because the difference is so big, your department must explain how you come up with this estimates.

Your calculation of expected revenue from the levy is also questionable. If one billion plastic shopping baps can really be reduced and one billion plastic shopping baps are still handed out after the levy, an annual revenue of \$500 million will be raised instead of \$200 million you estimated.

Accordingly, either the EPD's estimated reduction of one billion is overstated (by 600 million bags) - which we believe to be the case; or the EPD is under-estimating the amount of revenue that it will receive (by \$300 million per year). The EPD's estimated reduction in plastic shopping bags and the amount of levy raised cannot be reconciled. We would therefore like to hear from you how these figures can be reconciled.

(c) Works on Review Mechanism

We are pleased to learn that a taskforce will be set up in July to start looking into the review mechanism of the scheme and we are also glad that HKRMA will be part of the taskforce. There is, however, no reason why work on review mechanism should not start now. As mentioned in our meeting, we believe that the existing working group for the implementation details of the levy scheme is well placed to discuss the review mechanism, as part of its ongoing work. To initiate the process, the HKRMA would like to submit the following recommendations on the review's scope and the necessary criteria for measuring the effectiveness of the levy:

- 1. Review objectives of the scheme;
- 2. Define "indiscriminate use" of plastic bags across Hong Kong;
- 3. Set targets for number of bags in Hong Kong to be reduced;
- 4. Determine methodology to calculate plastic bag usage and re-usage in Hong Kong.
- 5. Measure "switching" behaviours of consumers resulting from the levy implementation; and
- 6. Review administration cost incurred by affected retailers.
