## **Panel on Development** Follow-up to Meeting on 28 April 2009

In considering the paper on PWP item 259RS – Cycle tracks connecting North West New Territories with North East New Territories at the meeting of the Panel on Development on 28 April 2009, Members requested the Administration to provide information on enhancement works that would be carried out by the Transport Department (TD) to existing cycle tracks on ramps of footbridges and subways (to be referred to as "cycle ramps"), with estimated We have consulted TD and would like to reply as timing and costs involved. follows.

In general, all existing cycle ramps are constructed in accordance with established standards (including limiting the maximum gradients between 8% and 10%) and are considered safe to cyclists provided that the traffic management measures implemented around these ramps are observed. Furthermore, as part of routine traffic management, TD regularly assess and review the safety of the cycle ramps and implement improvement measures where necessary to enhance the safety of cyclists. A list of on-going and planned improvement works undertaken by TD is at Annex.

I should be most grateful if you would convey the above to Members for their information.
