# Supplementary information on review of Hong Kong's Air Quality Objectives and Development of Long-Term Air Quality Management Strategy

I am writing to ask the administration to provide the following supplementary information before next meeting.

#### Question 1

Provide the methodology and assumptions for the calculation of the cost-benefit analysis in the review, including \$3.8 billion for low emissions zones and re-routing buses.

### **Question 2**

Provide the methodology for the air modeling in the review, including emission data inputs and assumptions, and the air model adopted in Tap Mun station.

#### **Question 3**

Provide the data that, if Hong Kong adopts IT-1, IT-2, IT-3, and full Air Quality Guidelines of WHO for each pollutant, how many days of violations/compliance would we have at each level.

#### **Question 4**

The health impacts and related medical costs when Hong Kong adopts at each of aforementioned levels, and how would they be calculated.

## **Question 5**

The principles adopted for setting the new AQOs, and the minutes of the meeting of the Advisory Panel related to the discussion on the new AQOs.
