## Capital works projects of **University Grants Committee-funded institutions**

At the meeting on 9 March 2009, the Panel on Education discussed the capital works project proposed by The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST) to construct two student hostel blocks accommodating 701 hostel places. Members requested the Administration to explore the possibility of increasing the capacity of the student hostels to fully meet the existing shortfall in publicly-funded hostel places, and to provide information on the average construction cost per square metre for the project.

A study by HKUST has shown that, given the site and planning constraints, the most feasible way of achieving this increase is by enlarging the footprint of the building which would encroach on the slope nearby. This would require a revised building design, additional tree-felling and significant geotechnical works, and hence the need to seek statutory approvals of the new plans. HKUST estimates that such an approach, if adopted, would cause a delay of six to nine months to the project. careful consideration, HKUST has decided not to adopt this approach, but to explore meeting the remaining shortfall by possible joint hostels with other UGC-funded institutions...

Capital works projects in the UGC-funded sector are initiated by the institutions. UGC does not impose any limits on the maximum number of hostel places in a block. Institutions would plan the provision of such places having regard to the individual circumstances of each project, including existing and future needs, site constraints and the campus development plan.

The estimated construction unit cost of project, represented by the building and building services costs, is \$12,562 per m<sup>2</sup> of construction floor area in September 2008 prices. In line with usual practice, we have included this estimate in our submission to the Public Works Subcommittee issued also today.
