Action

I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman for the 2008-2009 session

Election of Chairman

Mr LEE Cheuk-yan, Member of the highest precedence in the Panel, presided over the election of Chairman of the Panel. <u>Mr LEE</u> called for nominations for the chairmanship of the Panel. Ms LI Fung-ying was nominated by Mr IP Kwok-him and the nomination was seconded by Mr WONG Kwok-kin. <u>Ms LI Fung-ying</u> accepted the nomination.

2. As there was no other nomination, <u>Mr LEE Cheuk-yan</u> declared Ms LI Fung-ying elected as the Chairman of the Panel for the 2008-2009 session. Ms LI then took the chair.

Election of Deputy Chairman

3. <u>The Chairman</u> called for nominations for the deputy chairmanship of the Panel. Mr WONG Kwok-kin was nominated by Mr WONG Kwok-hing and the nomination was seconded by Mr IP Kwok-him. <u>Mr WONG Kwok-kin</u> accepted the nomination.

4. As there was no other nomination, <u>the Chairman</u> declared Mr WONG Kwok-kin elected as Deputy Chairman of the Panel for the 2008-2009 session.

II. Schedule of meetings for the 2008-2009 session

5. <u>Members</u> agreed that future regular meetings of the Panel would be held on the third Thursday of each month at 2:30 pm.

III. Items for discussion at the next meeting (LC Paper Nos. CB(2)62/08-09(01) and (02))

6. <u>Members</u> agreed that the following items proposed by the Administration would be discussed at the regular meeting to be held on 20 November 2008 -

- (a) Overall review of the Wage Protection Movement for cleaning workers and security guards, and progress report on preparatory work for introducing a bill on a statutory minimum wage; and
- (b) An overview on the promotional efforts of the Labour Department on labour-related matters.

7. <u>Members</u> agreed that one of the following items would be discussed at the regular meeting on 20 November 2008 -

- (a) Making non-compliance with Labour Tribunal awards a criminal offence;
- (b) Inclusion of general holidays as statutory holidays; and
- (c) Review of the Transport Support Scheme.

8. <u>Members</u> agreed that the Clerk should liaise with the Administration to ascertain the appropriate timing for discussion of the above items and consult the Chairman accordingly.

(*Post-meeting note:* At the request of the Administration and with the concurrence of the Chairman, the items "Creation of a Chief Labour Officer post for the introduction of the statutory minimum wage legislation" and "Enhancement of current surveys and introduction of new surveys for the purpose of implementing a statutory minimum wage" have been added to the agenda for the next meeting. The Chairman instructed that the items proposed by members in paragraph 7 above be scheduled for discussion at future meetings.)

Items for discussion at future meetings

9. <u>Mr WONG Kwok-hing</u> said that in their letter to the Chairman, LegCo Members affiliated with the Hong Kong Federation of Trade Unions had proposed 11 items for discussion in the 2008-2009 legislative session. As some of the items were already on the "List of issues suggested to be considered", <u>members</u> agreed that the list of outstanding items for discussion should be updated to incorporate the items proposed in the letter, where appropriate.

(*Post-meeting note:* The letter to the Chairman was issued to members vide LC Paper No. CB(2)39/08-09 on 15 October 2008.)

IV. Any other business

10. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded members that the briefings by the Secretary for Labour and Welfare and the Secretary for Education on the Chief Executive's 2008-2009 Policy Address had been scheduled for 23 October 2008 from 10:30 am to 11:30 am.
