The Legislative Council Subcommittee on Poverty Alleviation continued its duty visit in Taiwan

The Legislative Council Subcommittee on Poverty Alleviation continued its duty visit in Taiwan today (July 21) to understand the poverty alleviation strategies and measures put in place to help the disadvantaged groups.

The delegation visited the Taiwan Fund for Children and Families in the morning to understand their work in protecting the poor and abused children. In the afternoon, the delegation met with the representatives of the Children Are Us Foundation and received briefing on the child caring and career counselling services provide for the mentally disable persons. They also visited a restaurant and a bakery run by the Foundation and operate by the mentally disable persons to understand their work. Members of the delegation also met with the Eden Social Welfare Foundation to get to know the caring and training services provided for the persons with disability.

The delegation will visit the Huashan Social Welfare Foundation (Elderly Welfare) and the National Association of Small and Medium Enterprises and attend a discussion forum on poverty alleviation in Taiwan tomorrow.
