Select Committee to Inquire into Matters relating to the Post-service Work of Mr LEUNG Chin-man

Proposed Work Plan

Purpose

This paper invites members to consider the proposed work plan of the Select Committee to Inquire into Matters relating to the Post-service Work of Mr LEUNG Chin-man ("the Select Committee").

Proposed work plan

2. The proposed work plan of the Select Committee has been formulated with reference to the work plans of three previous Select Committees, a summary of which is provided in **Appendix I**; and the proposed major areas of study of the Select Committee. Members may wish to conduct work in three main stages listed below.

Stage I - Preparatory work (Internal deliberations – about eight weeks)

- 3. The main activities during this stage are:
 - (a) to draw up and determine the practice and procedure of the Select Committee;
 - (b) to work out and decide on the areas of study of the Select Committee;
 - (c) to decide on the information to be obtained from relevant parties, receive briefings by the Secretariat on information obtained and on the sequence of events of incidents relating to the areas of study, analyze relevant information; and
 - (d) to identify the witnesses to be summonsed, decide on the order of the witnesses and the main areas of evidence to be obtained.

<u>Stage II - Obtaining and deliberation on evidence from witnesses (Conduct of hearings - about 22 weeks)</u>

4. The main activities during this stage are to obtain evidence from witnesses in respect of the areas of study and to consider the evidence obtained. The duration of this stage will depend on the scope of study, the number of witnesses summonsed, and the complexity of the issues involved.

<u>Stage III - Preparation of and discussion on the draft report of the Select Committee</u> (Internal deliberations – about eight weeks)

- 5. The main activities during this stage are:
 - (a) to deliberate on the evidence obtained;
 - (b) to discuss the approach in drafting the report of the Select Committee;
 - (c) to prepare the draft report;
 - (d) to discuss the draft report; and
 - (e) to seek the comments (if any) of any person(s)/organization(s) against whom adverse comments are intended to be made on the relevant parts of the draft report.
- 6. It is proposed that the Select Committee will proceed as follows:
 - (a) **from mid December 2008 to mid February 2009** to hold internal deliberations;
 - (b) **from mid February to July 2009** to conduct hearings to receive evidence from witnesses; and
 - (c) **from August 2009 onwards** depending on the progress of (b), to prepare the report and hold internal deliberations to discuss the report.

Proposed schedule of meetings

7. Subject to endorsement of the proposed work plan outlined in paragraph 6 above, and having regard to the meeting schedule of other committees of the Council, it is proposed that the Select Committee may hold two meetings or hearings per week. The tentative schedule of meetings from January to July 2009 is in **Appendix II**. The proposed timing includes a pre-hearing and a post-hearing internal meeting, each lasting for 30 minutes, if the meeting is a hearing.

Advice sought

8. Members are invited to endorse the proposed work plan in paragraph 6 and the proposed schedule of meetings or hearings in paragraph 7 above.
