Further witness statement of Mrs Carrie WONG HO Ka-lai

I, Carrie WONG HO Ka-lai, am the Chief Executive Officer (Pensions) of the Civil Service Bureau. I am asked to appear before the Select Committee to Inquire into Matters Relating to the Post-service Work of Mr LEUNG Chin-man and to provide further information on the issues raised by the Select Committee.

- Q(a) the number of post-service work applications from directorate civil servants considered by the Advisory Committee on Post-service Employment of Civil Servants ("ACPE") by way of discussion at meetings of ACPE since the introduction of the new arrangements governing the post-service work taken up by directorate civil servants in January 2006; and
- Q(b) the dates of the meetings convened by ACPE to discuss the post-service work applications mentioned in (a) above and the number of applications considered at each of these meetings.
- A(a)&(b) As mentioned in my earlier witness statement dated 26 March 2009, since the introduction of the new arrangement on I January 2006 and up to the end of December 2008, a total of 171 applications were approved and four applications were rejected by the decision authority, after consideration by ACPE (excluding one application which was subsequently withdrawn by the applicant after consideration by ACPE). All these 176 applications (including the withdrawn one) were considered by the circulation of papers.
