# EDUCATION ORDINANCE (Cap. 279) EDUCATION ORDINANCE (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE 3) NOTICE 2009

#### **INTRODUCTION**

The Secretary for Education (SED) will amend Schedule 3 to the Education Ordinance (Cap. 279) (the Ordinance) by the Education Ordinance (Amendment of Schedule 3) Notice 2009 (Notice) to be published in the Gazette. This brief explains the Notice at **Annex A**.

#### **JUSTIFICATION**

- 2. The Ordinance requires all aided schools to set up an Incorporated Management Committee (IMC) to enhance transparency and accountability of school management. Direct Subsidy Scheme (DSS) schools and a list of specified schools in Schedule 3 to the Ordinance can however decide whether to apply to the Permanent Secretary for Education for establishing an IMC under the Ordinance.
- 3. Section 40AC of the Ordinance sets out the requirements which a school has to meet before being specified in Schedule 3, and provides that SED may by notice published in the Gazette amend Schedule 3. In essence, these schools are non-DSS, non-aided primary or secondary schools in

receipt of government subsidies such as the Capital Grant and Per Caput Grant. Copies of section 40AC of the Ordinance and Schedule 3 are at **Annex B**.

4. Owing to cessation of operation of two schools and addition of a new eligible school, SED needs to amend Schedule 3 to bring it up-to-date.

#### THE NOTICE

- 5. The Notice made under section 40AC of the Ordinance is to amend Schedule 3 by
  - (a) deleting Hong Kong Sam Yuk Secondary School and Sam Yuk Middle School which have ceased operation; and
  - (b) adding a new school, namely, Discovery College, which meets all the requirements in section 40AC(2) of the Ordinance for being specified in Schedule 3.

#### LEGISLATIVE TIMETABLE

6. The Notice will be published in the Gazette on 27 March 2009 and tabled at the Legislative Council for negative vetting on 1 April 2009. Subject to negative vetting, the Notice will come into operation on 21 May 2009.

**IMPLICATIONS** 

7. The amendments to Schedule 3 have no economic, sustainability,

financial or civil service implications. The Notice is in conformity with the

Basic Law, including the provisions concerning human rights. It will not

affect the current binding effect of the Ordinance.

**PUBLIC CONSULTATION** 

8. The amendments are to update the factual information of the list of

specified schools in Schedule 3. Public consultation is not necessary.

(Made by the Secretary for Education under section 40AC(1) of the Education Ordinance (Cap. 279))

#### 1. Commencement

This Notice comes into operation on 21 May 2009.

### 2. Specified schools

Schedule 3 to the Education Ordinance (Cap. 279) is amended –

(a) by adding –

"Discovery College 38 Siena Avenue, Discovery

Bay, Lantau Island, New

Territories";

(b) by repealing –

"Hong Kong Sam Yuk 17A Ventris Road, Hong

Secondary School Kong";

(c) by repealing –

"Sam Yuk Middle School 1111 Clear Water Bay Road,

Sai Kung, New Territories".

## **Explanatory Note**

This Notice amends Schedule 3 to the Education Ordinance (Cap. 279) ("the Ordinance") –

- (a) to add one school to that Schedule; and
- (b) to delete 2 schools from that Schedule.
- 2. Where a school is specified in that Schedule, the sponsoring body of the school may apply to establish an incorporated management committee in respect of the school in accordance with sections 40BJ to 40BN of the Ordinance.

#### Annex B

#### **Education Ordinance (Cap.279) - Section 40AC**

#### Secretary for Education may amend Schedule 3

- (1) The Secretary for Education may by notice published in the Gazette amend Schedule 3.
- (2) A school shall not be specified in Schedule 3 unless
  - (a) the school is a primary school or secondary school;
  - (b) the school is neither an aided school nor a Direct Subsidy Scheme school;
  - (c) the school is a school without incorporated management committee;
  - (d) the school is not operated for the purpose of making profit;
  - (e) the sponsoring body of the school is not a profit-making organization;
  - (f) the school receives any subsidy from the Government; and
  - (g) the school is, in the opinion of the Permanent Secretary for Education, financially sound.
