PRACTISING CERTIFICATE (SOLICITORS) (AMENDMENT) RULES 2009

(Made by the Council of The Law Society of Hong Kong under section 73 of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Cap. 159) with the prior approval of the Chief Justice)

1. Commencement

Section 3 comes into operation on 1 January 2010.

2. Fee for practising certificate

Rule 3 of the Practising Certificate (Solicitors) Rules (Cap. 159 sub. leg. L) is amended by repealing "Society a fee of \$6,800." and substituting—
"Society—

- (a) in relation to a practising certificate for a period not exceeding one calendar year and ending on 31 December 2009, a fee of \$6,800;
- (b) in relation to a practising certificate for a period not exceeding one calendar year and ending on or after 31 December 2010, a fee of \$5,000.".

3. Fee for practising certificate

Rule 3 is amended by repealing everything after "to the Society" and substituting "a fee of \$5,000.".
