Objection to Embrace HKTDC into the Competition Laws

Since the introduction of the Competition Bills, various ideas have been received from aspect of the community; however, majority of supporters are from rich and lucrative commercial bodies, basing on reasons not difficult to understand. In the past decade, the Hong Kong Trade Development Council (HKTDC) has spared no effort in assisting the SMEs; among which Jewellery traders are the most benefited.
