## I. Meeting with the Administration

[The Bill and LC Paper Nos. CB(2)1723/10-11(01), CB(2)1859/10-11 and CB(2)1802/10-11]

The Bills Committee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

Committee Stage amendments ("CSAs") proposed by the Administration

2. The Administration took members through its proposed CSAs to

individual clauses of the Bill. <u>Members</u> raised no objection to the Administration's proposed CSAs. <u>Members</u> noted that the Administration would make further amendments to clauses 8 and 39 of the Bill.

#### <u>Legislative timetable</u>

- The Administration advised that it proposed to resume the Second 3. Reading debate on the Bill at the Council meeting of 15 June 2011. to the passage of the Bill, the Administration proposed to gazette the Commencement Notice on 30 June 2011 and to appoint the same date as the day on which the Residential Care Homes (Persons with Disabilities) Ordinance ("the RCHD Ordinance") (except Part 2 on sanctions) would come into operation. The Secretary for Labour and Welfare ("SLW") would gazette another Commencement Notice for Part 2 of the Ordinance after the expiry of the 18-month grace period. The Administration further advised that it was preferable that the Residential Care Homes (Persons with Disabilities) Regulation ("the Regulation") to be made under section 24 of the RCHD Ordinance was made after most parts of the Ordinance had come into operation. In view of its target to introduce the Regulation before the end of the current legislative session, the Administration therefore proposed to appoint the gazettal date of the Commencement Notice as the day on which the Ordinance (except Part 2 on sanctions) would come into operation.
- 4. The legal adviser to the Bills Committee drew members' attention to section 32(1) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) which stipulated that "where an Ordinance is to come into operation on a day other than the day of its publication in the Gazette, a power to do anything under the Ordinance may be exercised at any time after its publication in the Gazette".
- 5. While appreciating the need to gazette the proposed Regulation as early as practicable so that the RCHD sector would be aware of the statutory requirements on the operation, management and supervision of RCHDs, and made rectification works within the 18-month grace period as appropriate, members considered it important to allow due process for the scrutiny of subsidiary legislation and not preferable for SLW to appoint a date for commencement of the RCHD Ordinance before the expiry of the negative vetting period for the subsidiary legislation. After taking into account members' views, the Administration agreed to revise the legislative timetable accordingly.

Action

6. To allow the RCHD sector to get prepared for the coming into force of the licensing scheme, members called on the Administration to submit the updated version of the Regulation which incorporated members' views made in the meetings of the Bills Committee as early as practicable. To allow sufficient time for scrutiny of the updated draft Regulation and in order not to delay the passage of the Bill, members considered that a subcommittee should be set up under the House Committee to study the updated version in detail.

#### Resumption of Second Reading debate on the Bill

7. The Chairman said that the full set of CSAs (including further amendments to clauses 8 and 39 of the Bill) proposed by the Administration would be circulated to members for consideration. If members had no further comments on the proposed amendments, the Bills Committee would report its deliberations to the House Committee on 27 May 2011.

(*Post-meeting note:* The Administration subsequently advised the Bills Committee vide LC Paper No. CB(2)1802/10-11(01) that it proposed to gazette the Commencement Notice and the Regulation on 30 June 2011 and appoint 11 November 2011 (i.e. after the expiration of the full negative vetting period on the assumption that the first Legislative Council meeting would be held on 12 October 2011) as the date on which both the Ordinance (except Part 2 on sanctions) and the Regulation would come into operation.)

## II. Any other business

8. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 11:47 am.
