VOLUNTARY COLLECTION SCHEME FOR SPENT COMPACT FLUORESCENT LAMPS

2. The Administration is requested-

"to provide a sample of the sticker label for the voluntary collection scheme on spent compact fluorescent lamps."

PLAN ON SUBSEQUENT PHASES OF THE MANDATORY ENERGY EFFICIENCY LABELLING SCHEME

4. The Administration is requested-

"to advise the Administration's plan on the third and subsequent phases of the mandatory Energy Efficiency Labelling Scheme (MEELS)."

5. We will review in 2010-11 the effectiveness of the MEELS, to assess its impact on consumers and the trades. We will also closely monitor the relevant international and local development (e.g. development of testing standards, availability of testing services in laboratories in Hong Kong and neighbouring areas). These will be taken into account in considering the way forward of MEELS.

AMENDMENT IN RESPECT OF DEHUMIDIFIERS

6. The Administration is requested-

"to provide the drafting of the proposed amendment in respect of the rated dehumidifying capacity of dehumidifiers."

7. With support from the Subcommittee, we plan to move amendment to narrow down the coverage of dehumidifiers from those with a rated dehumidifying capacity not exceeding 87 Litres (L) to those not exceeding 35L. The draft resolution is at the **Annex**, which is planned to be moved at the Legislative Council meeting on 6 January 2010.
