Follow-up actions required to be taken by the Administration

2. <u>The Subcommittee</u> requested the Administration to provide written information in response to members' requests raised at the meeting -

- (a) clarify the definition of "industrial building" in the Notice, and consider whether reference should be made to the current usage of the building stated in the occupation permit concerned, and review whether the current definition would in-principle cover all industrial buildings in lots that were not located within an industrial zone, in accordance with the plan approved under the Buildings Ordinance;
- (b) the number of tenants/minority owners currently engaging in creative and cultural works and operating in affected industrial buildings in the third class of lot specified in the Notice; and
- (c) the number, with breakdown by age, of local buildings with 9 units or below on a lot with each of the units representing more than 10% of all the undivided shares in the lot.

3. The Subcommittee had completed scrutiny of the Notice. <u>Members</u> noted that the deadline of giving notice to move amendments to the subsidiary legislation was 10 March 2010 by which the Subcommittee would also submit its written report to the House Committee.
